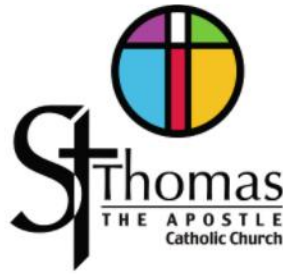

Now that we have raised the funds for new pews and they have been ordered, we will prepare for the installation of the pews when they are ready next year. In the meantime, we can continue to raise funds to extend the décor in the sanctuary through the nave of the church. If we raise sufficient funds, we can use the time when the pews are removed to bring the stenciling and other decorative elements into the main body of the church. Obviously, it will be less expensive to do this while the pews are removed. If we take up this work after the pews are installed, we would have to install a more complex scaffold system to add decoration at a later date. Thank you for considering this request.

We plan to offer extra confessions next weekend after Masses which is a great opportunity to be absolved of your sins. When Advent begins, I plan to increase the opportunities for confession.
