Parish Nurse Notes

November was **National Diabetes Month**, a time when communities across the country seek to bring attention to diabetes. This year's focus is on taking action to prevent diabetes health problems.

Know your diabetes ABCs

A for the A1C test

The A1C is a blood test that measures your average blood sugar level over the past three months. It is different from the blood sugar checks you do each day.

You need to know your blood sugar levels over time. You don't want those numbers to get too high. High levels of blood sugar can harm your heart, blood vessels, kidneys, feet, and eyes.

The A1C goal for many people with diabetes is below 7. It may be different for you. Ask what your goal should be.

B for Blood pressure

Blood pressure is the force of your blood against the wall of your blood vessels.

If your blood pressure gets too high, it makes your heart work too hard. It can cause a heart attack, stroke, and damage your kidneys and eyes. The blood pressure goal for most people with diabetes is below 140/90. It may be different for you. Ask what your goal should be.

C for Cholesterol

There are two kinds of cholesterol in your blood: LDL and HDL.

LDL or "bad" cholesterol can build up and clog your blood vessels. It can cause a heart attack or stroke. HDL or "good" cholesterol helps remove the "bad" cholesterol from your blood vessels.

Ask what your cholesterol numbers should be. Your goals may be different from other people. If you are over 40 years of age, you may need to take a statin drug for heart health.

✓ Actions you can take

- Ask your health care team:
 - * what your A1C, blood pressure, and cholesterol numbers are and what they should be. Your ABC goals will depend on how long you have had diabetes, other health problems, and how hard your diabetes is to manage.
 - * what you can do to reach your ABC goals
- Write down your numbers on the record at the back of this booklet to track your progress (found on the NIH website or make your own) [4 Steps to Manage Your Diabetes for Life - NIDDK \(nih.gov\)](#)

Living Well With Diabetes

Being active most days is a pro move for managing diabetes.

You don't get really good at dealing with diabetes overnight. But over time, you'll figure out how to go from getting it done to taking it in stride. See if any of these tips are familiar (or worth trying!).

- Make and eat healthy food.
- Be active most days.
- Test your blood sugar often.
- Take medicines as prescribed, even if you feel good.
- Learn ways to manage stress.
- Cope with the emotional side of diabetes.
- Go to checkups.
