

The Epiphany of the Lord



**Lord, every nation
on earth will adore you**



From Our Pastor

This weekend is the Epiphany, a word that means to "shine forth." We celebrate the light of Christ that shines forth on the world. This feast day commemorates three moments in the life of Christ. First and foremost, the revelation of the Christ to the three magi who bring their gifts to the newborn King of Israel, gold, frankincense, and myrrh. This feast day also commemorates the baptism of Jesus in which the Father revealed Jesus as his beloved Son; listen to Him! Also, in the wedding feast at Cana, Jesus performs his first miracle in changing water into wine. The Baptism of the Lord will be celebrated on Monday, January 8, and marks the close of the Christmas Season.

I take this opportunity to review our baptism practice at St. Thomas. Parents who are presenting their first child for baptism at St. Thomas must participate in a baptism class. The class is a single session scheduled at a convenient time with one of the priests or a catechist. Parents who have participated in the class do not need to repeat the class to have additional children baptized.

The best time for baptisms is on Sunday, either with the community at the 10 a.m. Mass or in private afterwards at 11 a.m. When this is not convenient, baptisms can also be scheduled on a Saturday morning or afternoon, or even on a weekday. The office can help put you in contact with one of the priests or deacons to confirm the date.

By presenting your child for baptism, parents commit to raising their child in the Catholic Faith. A godparent must be chosen. If there are two godparents, they must be a godfather and a godmother. At least one godparent must be a baptized and confirmed practicing Catholic in good standing, generally over the age of 16.

Children may be presented for baptism up to the age of reason, around 7 years of age or second grade. Older children must go through some catechetical preparation before they are baptized. It is recommended that older children enter the Church at the Easter Vigil.

Finally, I draw your attention to the Progressive dinner to take place January 20th. This is a fun and enjoyable evening to gather with parish and school families and meet new people. There are a few days left, so please sign up soon to participate.

John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants

Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply. **Deadline date for the completed application is April 26, 2024.** Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Thomas the Apostle Church Annual Report

The St. Vincent de Paul Society Conference at St. Thomas Church is comprised of 41 members, Vincentians, who answer and respond to our clients/friends in need (FINs) calls for assistance. requests. There are also several volunteers who work in the food pantry. Within that group of volunteers, we have a spiritual advisor, a finance coordinator, a scheduling coordinator and four call assignment coordinators. Our group volunteers their time to keep this complex program running.

We receive calls from the *St. Vincent de Paul Helpline* which serves several other Peoria Area conferences as well. The calls that we receive are from those in distress who need help with utility payments, bus passes, rent, and food. Many times, we receive these calls when evictions are imminent and utility disconnections are pending. Two Vincentians work in teams on each call. We continue to deliver food in emergencies. Each call takes 1-1.5 hours and each Vincentian takes 1-2 calls per week. There are times we are not able to help a FIN because they are too far in debt or when they have called for help too frequently. We try to assist as many people as possible while being prudent stewards of the monies provided by your donations.

For the fiscal year ended September 30, 2023 we made 284 calls and helped 638 people.

The *Coming Together to Get Ahead* program is a 16-week program for our FINs within the Peoria Diocese. The program is being resurrected and will be held in 2024 or 2025. This program provides education to improve life skills and better decision making.



