

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple

Friday, February 2nd is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple, the traditional end of the Christmas season. On this day we commemorate Mary's and Joseph's adherence to the Mosaic law as they entered the Temple for the ritual purification. Also, forty days was the time after which a firstborn male child was brought to the Temple to be dedicated to the Lord. The Presentation is a proclamation of Christ – Messiah and Priest, Lord and Savior. He is the light who came into this world to dispel sin and darkness. For this reason, at least since the seventh century, candles have been blessed at Mass this day, hence coining the term Candlemas.

Candles to be used throughout the liturgical year will be blessed at the 7:00 a.m. Mass which will include a pro-

cession with candles. If you attend this Mass, you will be able to take one of the blessed candles to use in your home. They are traditionally lit during storms or in the rooms of the sick. They can also be used during time of personal prayer or for other family celebrations.

John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award. Parents must apply at: https:// online.factsmgt.com/ aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply. Deadline date for the completed application is April 26, 2024. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus

Poverty and financial struggle weigh on so many in Peoria. Here in Peoria, people with an income below poverty level in 2021 (most recent State report available), was 22.5% of the total population vs 12.1% in the state as a whole. The largest demographic living in poverty are Females 25-34.

In November of 2022 our Food Pantry served a total of 300 persons. This past year, in November of 2023 our Pantry served 665 persons, a more than two fold increase.

As evidenced above, these are times of great stress, financial hardship, and worry for many of our neighbors. Monthly bills are a juggling act, especially for those on fixed income.

Pope Francis recently reminded us that it is the calling of every Christian to become personally involved in the plight of the poor. All the gifts that God has given us, be it little or great, are not to be used just for ourselves. They are to be used in the service of others, and in the service of God who gave them to us.

Will you help us? We cannot provide food and monetary assistance without YOUR help! You can make a difference to those in need in Peoria.


