Thanks to the hard work of the Men's Club, we look forward to the Fish Fry on March 8th. If you haven't purchased tickets, I encourage you to do so. I am grateful to the Men's Club for the many ways they support the parish and school, both by hosting social events and by fundraising for projects that benefit our parish and school.

During Lent, we are encouraged to pray, and it is always good to remember to pray for the dead. 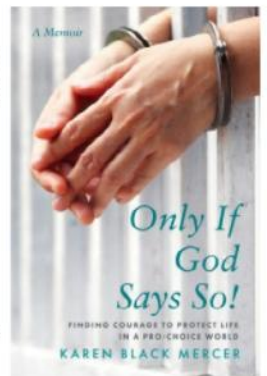

KAREN BLACK MERCER

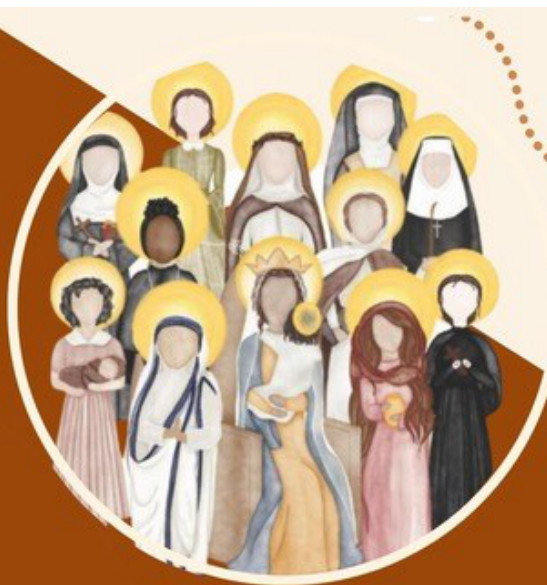


For fifty-four years, Karen Black Mercer, whose memoir is *Only If God Says So! Finding Courage to Protect Life in a Pro-Choice World*, has been a warrior against abortion, starting in the late sixties to prevent abortion on demand. She has worked with crisis pregnancy centers, done post-abortion counseling, and joined Operation Rescue. She's been pushed, spit on, handcuffed, beaten, injured by nunchucks, shackled, arrested twenty-four times, and received a mafia death threat. Her compassionate woman-centered approach to encouraging women to choose life over abortion has resulted in over nine thousand women choosing life and has earned her

national recognition as "The Billy Graham of Sidewalk Counseling." She has also earned the Power of One award from the Georgia Family Council. Karen holds a doctorate in clinical Christian counseling (PhD). In addition to her two children, she has a stepdaughter and total of ten grandchildren. She lives in the Midwest with her husband.
