

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



At any point in your life, have you ever been in need?

If not, you are truly blessed. The individuals and families whom we help through our SVdP Society have often exhausted their ability to get help from family or friends, and they are unaware of other resources. The goal of SVdP is to help these members of our community to bridge these challenges during some of the lowest points of their lives. This happened with a young woman when she was expecting her second child. She had graduated from high school and has passed her program to be a certified medical assistant. "Kay" was working in a doctor's office at a local hospital when she began to have multiple complications with her pregnancy. Her physician did some tests, and he recommended that she go on complete bedrest in order to save her baby. Kay did not know how she would pay her rent and utilities. plus she had not been employed long enough to receive other benefits.

I had met Kay about a year ago, though I did not learn her story until she was checking my vitals at a December 2023 office visit. While chatting, she asked me what I was doing in retirement. I told her that I volunteered with a group which helped people with rent, utilities and other needs through the donations of parish members. Kay then asked me what the name of my group was, and I told her it was the St. Vincent de Paul group at St. Thomas Church. She broke into a big smile and got tears in her eyes as she explained that it was our group and parish which helped her when she was trying to save her baby's life. Kay told me that the people who had visited and worked with her also provided other information about resources. Her baby had been born healthy and was now 3 years old. Kay then asked me to thank our group and to let them know how much their help had meant to her family. This past Friday I returned to the office where she worked, and asked me if I was still doing volunteer work with people in need. She hugged me as I left the office. This young woman is a heroine to me.
