

## From Our Pastor

We look forward to the progress we will make this summer on replacing pews, kneelers, and carpet in the church and in the narthex. We will also extend the stencil design in the sanctuary throughout the body of the church. Thank you to all those who donated to make this a possibility.

The work will begin after Pentecost and the day of graduation, May 19 and will continue through July. During this time, we will set up chairs and continue to have weekend Masses in the church. Daily Masses will move to the chapel. Thank you for your accommodation while we undertake this work.

The application and required supporting tax documents (your 2023 tax return and W-2's) must be received online by FACTS by the application deadline date of April 26, 2024. There is a \$40.00 fee required in order to complete the FACTS application.

Completion of the FACTS application by the April 26, 2024 deadline makes you eligible to receive financial aid from the John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund through the Diocese of Peoria and the St. Thomas Parish Sponsor a Student Fund.


