

From Our Pastor

Today we celebrate the Ascension of Our Lord. While traditionally celebrated as Ascension Thursday, in this territory the Ascension is observed on Sunday.

The Ascension marks Jesus' return to the right hand of the Father and completes the work that began when Jesus descended out of Heaven and took flesh in the womb of the Blessed Mother. As Jesus goes up into Heaven, it is a promise for us as well that we who are part of the mystical Body of Christ are called to be with Jesus in Heaven for all eternity. The Ascension is connected to next week's celebration of Pentecost since Jesus said that after he returned to the Father, he would send us an Advocate, the Holy Spirit.

Next weekend we will have three new deacons ordained for the Diocese of Peoria: Benjamin Schoonmaker, Francis Strong, and Jack Watt. The following weekend we will have four new priests ordained for this Diocese. They are Deacons Nicholas Conner, Jacob Martini, Justin Ramza, and Jack Swoik. Please remember to pray for them as they approach ordination.

Our current pews will be removed on Monday, May 20th. I have learned that St. Columba Church in Ottawa, Illinois, will not be able to take our pews since they do not fit the layout in that church. Anyone who is interested in claiming a pew should contact the parish office so we can plan for this. You are welcome to any of the pews. There is only one catch: You must be ready to claim the pew and transport it on Monday, May 20th. After this, the church will be cleared out as we begin removing old carpet and begin the work of painting and decoration.

The entire project should take about eight weeks. We will be using chairs in the meantime for weekend Masses. Thank you for your understanding during this transition as we look forward to the installation of new pews.


Volunteers Needed




