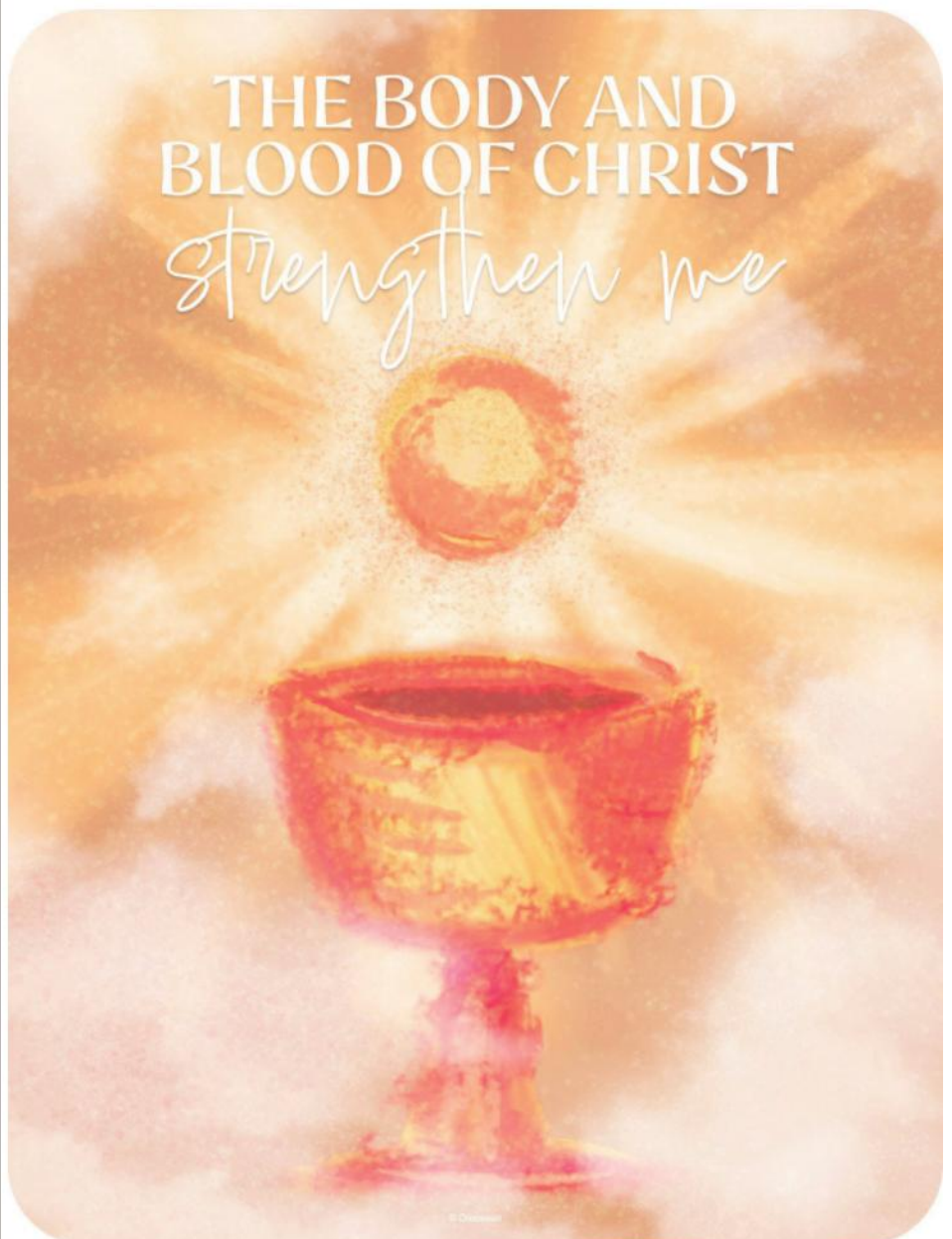

From Our Pastor

This weekend we celebrate *Corpus Christi*, the feast of the *Body and Blood of Christ*.

During this Eucharistic year, our bishops have asked us to give renewed attention to the Eucharist and deepen our devotion to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. We do this in our public prayer when we participate in the Mass and prepare ourselves to receive Communion. We also do this in our private prayer, especially prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, in which we lift our minds and hearts to the Lord individually. We can also grow in our love for the Eucharist through devotions, such as exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and in Eucharistic Processions.

This Sunday after the 10 am Mass, we will have a Eucharistic Procession as we carry the Blessed Sacrament outside of the Church in a solemn procession around our immediate neighborhood. You are invited to come and take part, by singing and praising the Lord. Those who made First Communion this year can wear your First Communion outfits again as you share in the devotion.

Please note the upcoming summer Bible school program *Totus Tuus*. The program will take place one week from now. If your children haven't signed up yet, please take time to do this. Children going into 1st through 6th grades will participate in a morning program, Monday through Friday. Teens going into 7th through 12th grade will participate in an evening program beginning Sunday night. A special thank you to those who are helping to host the *Totus Tuus* team during that week.

Care for Creation

LAUDATO SI', mi' Signore – Praise be to you, my Lord. These are the words that open Pope Francis' encyclical on ecology and care for God's creation. These words, quoting St. Francis of Assisi's beautiful canticle, remind us that our common home is like a sister with whom we share our life and a beautiful mother who opens her arms to embrace us.

Last fall Pope Francis released Laudate Deum, reminding us of the urgency of the Laudato Si' message. He wrote, *There are no lasting changes without cultural changes, and there are no cultural changes without personal changes.* Pray this week to become aware and be open to the changes that will be presented each week in the bulletin.

When eating at a buffet restaurant or on a picnic, you can help conserve natural resources and reduce waste by taking just one plate, one napkin and only the utensils you need. Encourage others to do the same.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



The St. Vincent de Paul Society was founded in the 1800s in France, in part by a Frenchman named Frederic Ozanam who was motivated by the life of St. Vincent de Paul, the Universal Patron of Charity. It was through God's grace that Vincent was inspired to go to the poor, spending decades ministering to them. Consequently, our society is named after him. Here at St. Thomas, we members and you, our generous parishioners, are involved in the 3 Ts: we share our time, talents, and our treasure with our neighbors in need.

Our time: When we receive the name of a neighbor who has called our Helpline, we (a team of 2) contact that neighbor by phone and set up a time to visit him or her. Go to the poor the Society encourages – see the face of Christ in the person whenever possible. The visit takes time, yet it is so important to join with our neighbor in the flesh – not just a voice over the phone. In that visit we, the team, determine if we can assist financially with the need. Sometimes we can't, but we can provide our trifold paper which contains many resources with respect to job training through Goodwill Commons, help with young children of single mothers through Family Core, help with food through our wonderful Food Pantry, help with financial planning through Navicore, help with job hunting through a 30 day bus pass for those who lack transportation, or any of the many other resources for help.

Our talent: Our members have so many different talents shared in our Society. Not so long ago, one of our members shared his business talent to create pictures of our Church's Blessed Mother mosaic, which many of you purchased providing resources for us to share with our neighbors. Another member acquired a storage space for donated furniture that can be given to neighbors who lack beds, tables, chairs. Other members share knowledge of resources that not all of us are aware of.

Our treasure: You, our parishioners, have been so very generous in providing the funds that allow us to go out to the faces of Christ, our neighbors, to make a difference in their challenging lives. So, you are our treasure. We are so grateful to you, and we keep you in our prayers. If you have plenty of the first T, time, please consider joining our Society. There is power in numbers. St. Vincent de Paul Society here at St. Thomas is always looking to grow!

Mission

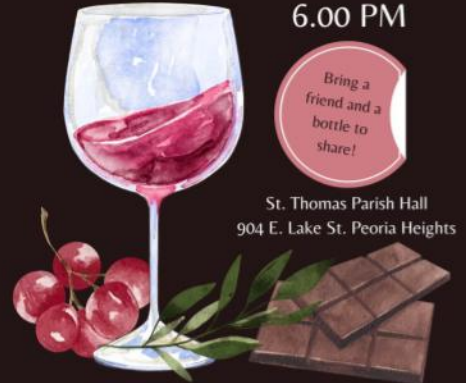


