

## From Our Pastor

We welcome Fr. Leopold Mushubozi this weekend as he becomes our new Parochial Vicar. You will get to know Fr. Leo as he spends time with us and gets accustomed to our parish. We also have Fr. Fortunatus Rutaihwa coming to St. Thomas as a new OSF chaplain with residence at St. Thomas. His primary work is at the hospital, so we will not see him as often at the parish.

We continue to make progress on the nave of the church. After cleaning the return ducts in the ceiling, I got a report about our HVAC system: It turns out that the air conditioning had to work harder, since it takes more energy to cool the hotter air up near the ceiling. We will adjust the dampers to close them in the summer so we don't draw hot air from the ceiling into the system, but we will open them in the winter, since drawing hot air into the system will save on heating costs. It's amazing to see what a difference it made to clean and open those clogged air ducts.

As we install pews, we will soon reach the time when we will not need to set up chairs. This also means that we don't need the extra wooden chairs with the blue fabric seats. Beginning July 8, we will be giving away the extra wooden chairs to any who want them. Note that we will keep the blue chairs in the chapel. It will only be the wooden chairs in the church that are available. As of July 8, they will be free and available to any who want them.

The Diocese of Peoria has sent a "traveling" monstrance around to the parishes of the Diocese during the Eucharistic revival. We will receive the monstrance for a Holy Hour on July 11. This will also be our regular monthly Holy Hour for July. Please join us in the evening for adoration.

Our All American Comets fundraiser at Haven on the Farm will be July 13. Please remember that you must purchase tickets in advance to attend, since food will be arranged based on those who have reserved their ticket. See you there!

## When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



Dear Parishioners of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish,

I felt compelled to give a few details on how The Society of St. Vincent de Paul came to be. The Society was founded in 1833 to help impoverished people living in the slums of Paris, France. The primary figure behind the Society's founding was Blessed Frederic Ozanam, a French lawyer, author, and professor in the Sorbonne. Frederic collaborated with Emmanuel Bailly, editor of the Tribune Catholique, in reviving a student organization which had been suspended during the revolutionary activity of July 1830. Ozanam was twenty (20) years old when he founded the Society. He was beatified by Pope John Paul 11 in 1997. Emmanuel Bailly was chosen as the first President. The Society took Saint Vincent de Paul as its patron under the influence of Sister Rosalie Rendu, DC. Sister Rosalie, beatified in November 1999 by Pope John Paul 11, was a member of the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul, earlier known for her work with people in the slums of Paris. She guided Frederic and his companions in their approach towards those in need. The Society gradually expanded outside of Paris in the mid-19th century.

The Society's first conference in the US was established in 1845 in St. Louis, Mo. At the Basilica of St. Louis King of France or Old Cathedral. Fr. John Timon, CM, had learned of the Society while visiting with his Vincentian superiors in Paris. From Dublin, Ireland, he brought to St. Louis copies of the SVdP Rule. On November 16, 1845, Bishop Peter Kenrick dedicated the new St. Vincent de Paul Church on South Eighth Street and invited Fr. Timon to preach. Fr. Timon discussed the Society in his sermon, in the presence of prominent St. Louis laymen who took hold of the idea and held an organizational meeting on November 20, 1845. The conference included Moses Linton, founder of the St. Louis Medical and Surgical Journal, and as chair Judge Bryan Mullanphy, who would become Mayor of St. Louis. Bishop Kenrick appointed Fr. Ambrose Helm as spiritual advisor to the Conference.

The national headquarters for the St. Vincent de Paul Society was established in St. Louis and membership has grown to over 100,000 in over 4400 US communities. Expenditures to "Friends in Need" in 2020 were over \$600M. Programs include visits to homes, prisons, and hospitals and provide funding for housing assistance, utilities, disaster relief, job training, food pantries, dining halls, clothing, furniture, transportation, care for the elderly, daycare assistance and medicine. Revenue is raised through parish laity donations and a large network of thrift stores.

In preparing this message to you and going back over some of my SVdP training materials I was struck by the power of the Holy Spirit in assembling the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. The Holy Spirit worked through all the groups associated with the Church: Clergy, Religious and the Laity. So, my message to you is you can make a difference if You take the time to listen to His Voice! Don't be afraid to act on what you hear. Christ is calling you. Get involved somewhere and sometime. Time waits for no man or woman. We, as Christians, are not given an indefinite amount of time, here on earth, to show our love and compassion for the poor. When we do show our love for the poor we show that love to Christ as well.

I leave you with a quote from St. Vincent de Paul himself and wish all of you a sincere *Sign of Peace*.

So, our vocation is to go, not just to one parish, not just to one diocese, but all over the world; and do what? To set people's hearts on fire, to do what the Son of God did. He came to set the world on fire in order to inflame it with His love.
