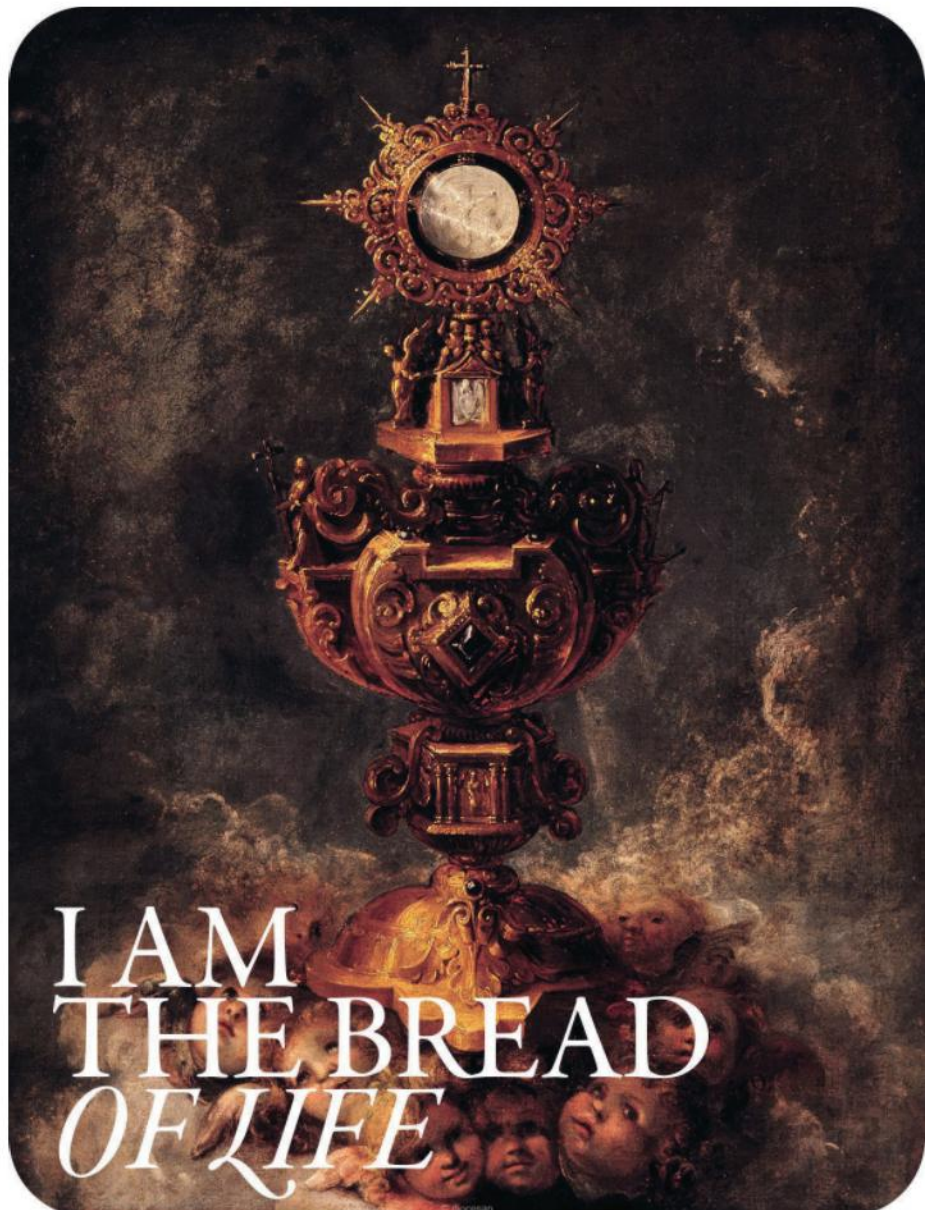

From Our Pastor

Thank you to those who have submitted Mass stipend requests. If you would like to have a Mass said for a loved one, please contact the parish office. The customary offering is \$10.

We have made progress this past week as kneelers have been installed in the church, much of the tile in the narthex has been laid, and the parish hall floor has been waxed.

Next weekend, August 3-4, we will celebrate the completion of this project. We will bless the pews and have a Donut Sunday after the Sunday morning Masses. The parish should be proud of St. Thomas the Apostle Church, since your generosity made these improvements possible!

Beginning this same weekend, we will ask our ushers to select parishioners to bring up the gifts at the offertory. We will also ask the ushers to begin passing the baskets for the collection once again. If you are asked by our ushers to help out, please be generous in volunteering.

In order to keep the church looking beautiful, I would like to invite all parishioners to pitch in. On Saturday morning, I propose that volunteers gather after the morning Mass. From 8:30 to 9:00 a.m. on Saturdays, volunteers can help by vacuuming, sweeping, and dusting. Because of the size of the church and school, the amount of work is often more than our janitorial staff can handle. The contribution that a group of volunteers can make in just a half-hour will go a long way to keeping St. Thomas Church spick and span.

If you want to help, please contact the parish office, or simply show up on Saturday morning. I will recognize service hours for any students who want to help.

Finally, we will begin our OCIA classes for converts and those who want to learn more about the Catholic faith. We will start after Labor Day on Wednesday, September 4th, at 7:00 p.m. in the parish hall.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus

My husband, John Pusey, died last August. He had asked me to name the St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Thomas Parish as the charity to which people could donate in his memory. I was a bit surprised that he didn't also mention a group he had supported that provides legal services to needy people. But he believed strongly in the mission of SVdP: to feed the hungry, to clothe the naked, to shelter the homeless, to help neighbors in need. People responded very generously and donated thousands of dollars to our SVdP treasury. But that money, well spent, didn't last long because there is so much need in our community of Peoria and Peoria Heights.

Most of the people who call the Catholic Charities HELP line are working but just can't cover all their bills, especially when an unexpected problem arises. For example, earlier this summer we helped a young woman with one little girl, who has a job with a major local company, but fell behind on her rent when her employer began rolling layoffs that cut her income in half. Wouldn't most of us be in a panic if we suddenly lost half our income? And wouldn't most of us be grateful to find a helping hand extended by Christians humbly following the teaching of Jesus to *love thy neighbor*?

We all have a role to play. Those of us who are members of the SVdP Society visit callers and determine how best to help them, while donors provide the financial resources needed. We can give items to the food pantry. And all of us can pray for the work we do as we *love our neighbors*. Thank you for your continued generous support.
