

From Our Pastor

Thank you to everyone that made our parish and school picnic so successful last Sunday. I can't remember the last time that we had such a full church for our 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. It was good to welcome the students back into the building as they dropped off their supplies before school started last Wednesday.

Since we have accomplished so much work in the church, I draw your attention to a few details that are with mentioning:

In the center of the narthex, we have inlaid a marble etching of the letter JMJ in honor of Archbishop Sheen. Many remember the JMJ he inscribed on every chalkboard when he lectured as a reminder of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. The script of the letters is taken from one of his letters in the Sheen Archive of the Diocese, so we can say that the JMJ is written in the narthex floor in Sheen's own handwriting.

During renovation, we set out a temporary bowl for holy water in the narthex. Since that work is done, we have restored the two angels to the narthex. You will find holy water in the shells in each statute. We don't want to distract from the inlaid mosaic in the narthex floor with the temporary bowl for holy water.

Finally, the kneeler in front of the sanctuary is there for those who prefer to kneel for Holy Communion. For several months, we have had parishioners kneel to receive the Eucharist. In order to make that safer and more convenient, we provided a kneeler. You may continue to receive Communion standing, either in the hand or on the tongue. For those who prefer, the kneeler is available.

Now that we have spent time to improve the external décor of the church, I take this time to consider the internal state of our soul. The holy soul that is beautiful inside is a reflection of the beauty we see manifest in the church building. Don't be comfortable simply with the sacred appearance of our church. Rather, sanctify your heart and soul, so as to make our celebration of the Mass truly beautiful in our church.

Next weekend will be an extra confession weekend as confessions will be heard after all Masses. Take advantage of this opportunity to be reconciled with Our Lord.


