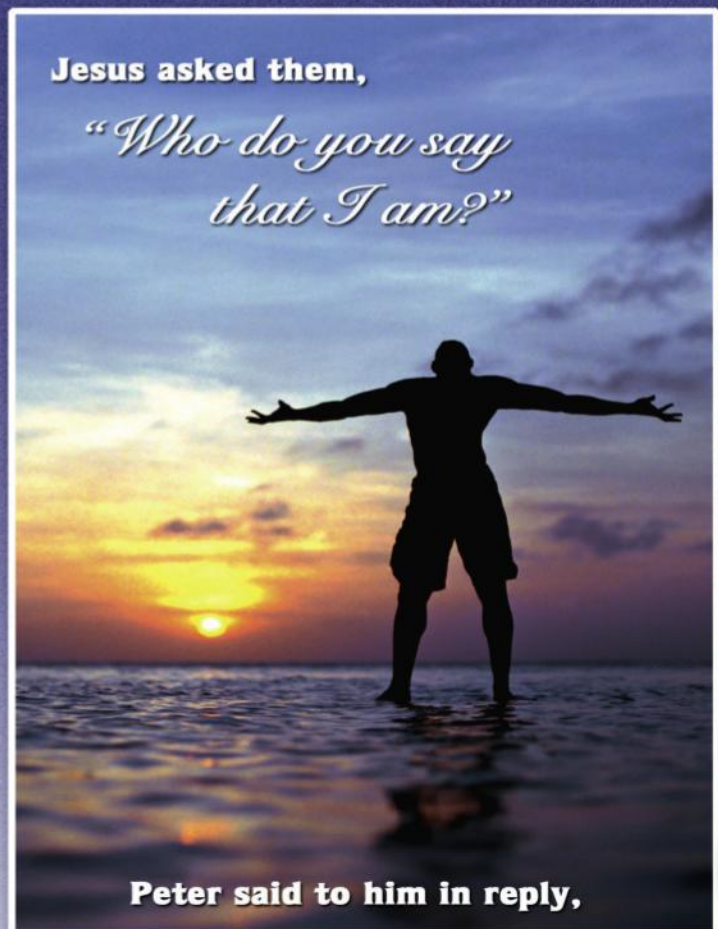

Last weekend we began *Lifeteen* for high school students. This program is a cooperative effort between St. Thomas, St. Vincent, and St. Anne parishes. I am happy to announce the good news that we had over 40 teens present for the first meeting. I am grateful to all those who have taken part as team leaders and coordinators to make this so successful. Meetings will continue monthly, rotating between the sponsoring parishes.

Unfortunately, there was a small response to the upcoming *Light of the World* retreat proposed in September. We will reschedule this for another time.

We will have our Parish Holy Hour this Thursday. In addition, we will begin the novena to St. Therese for vocations on Saturday, September 21st. 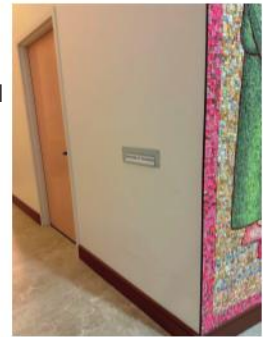
Schedule Change
