

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus

August, traditionally our busiest month, was very challenging this year. We answered 54 calls for

assistance, and through your generosity we were able to provide nearly \$15,000 to families with almost 150 members. The calls were all unique and as we met with the families, we found ways to suggest other steps they may take for a better future. Many are challenged by employment, housing, and utility situations that become burdensome. In all these situations we rely on God's grace, your prayers and donations to find some answers for them.

One example comes to mind. A lady called us for a bus pass to get to work. It seems that was the biggest need she had. We learned she and her 6 children live in a rented house with her partner. The children aged 5 to 15 all attend school and are active in many sports, etc. We asked if she had enough food. She said she could use some as it was the end of the month. Through the generosity of our food pantry, we were able to take several bags of groceries to her. During our visit, we learned that she has no car, a part time job, and receives government assistance for her rent, food stamps and her son's disability income. She is taking courses online through ICC to become a Medical Office Assistant. She says, "everything is going pretty well as long as my multiple sclerosis is in check". We provided a few suggestions for more resources she might consult. We assured her that we would be praying for her and her family.

In the society of St. Vincent de Paul we strive to grow spiritually so we can better respond to our Neighbors in Need with compassion, understanding and support. You help us provide when the needs are great as they were in August. Thank you, and may God bless you.
