From Our Pastor

I am grateful for Fr. Leo's help last week as I was in Albuquerque at the Canon Law Society of America Convention. During that meeting, I was able to give presentations on the investigation of causes of beatification and canonization of saints. Since causes of saints require a detailed and thorough investigation by the Church, canon lawyers have a special role in these processes and it was good to be able to share information about this part of ecclesiastical law.

I can confirm that interest in the Venerable Servant of God Archbishop Fulton Sheen is very high, and many want to know about recent developments. I have shared, in particular, the inlaid marble image of the JMJ in our narthex. According to pious tradition, Sheen would honor Jesus, Mary, and Joseph in this three letter inscription that he wrote on the chalkboards or papers he used. This image is a reproduction of Sheen's own handwritten JMJ and was scanned from one of his own handwritten notes in the archives of the Sheen Museum. I'm not aware of any other church that has reproduced this pious inscription, so we have a unique and special element at St. Thomas that exists nowhere else.

This week the Bishop will gather on Tuesday and Wednesday with the priests of this Diocese for our priests' Assembly Days. During these days, the priests will spend time with one another and with our Bishop. We spend time learning about any updates to the initiatives of the Diocese.

I ask you to remember the priests of this Diocese in your prayers. Pray also for our Bishop, our seminarians, and the future seminarians who may be called to study for the priesthood. May God bless us and strengthen us in his service.




