

### From Our Pastor

In October each year, the parishes of the Diocese take a count of all the people attending Mass over two weekends for statistical purposes. We had 794 people attending this year. This is an improvement since Covid over 2020 (618 people), 2021 (705 people), 2022 (771 people). However, it is a drop from last year in 2023 (889 people).

It is possible that last year was an unusual year, since the weekends for our Mass counts were held on the weekends on which we hosted the Diocesan Seminarian Support Group and the Light of the World Retreat. However, I bring this to our attention, since I believe there is still much work to be done in bringing the faithful back to the Mass.

I brought this subject to our Parish Council to discuss ways we can encourage Mass attendance and greater engagement with the Faith among parishioners, and especially our school families.

I am also happy to announce that we have reached our parish goal for the Annual Diocesan Appeal. However, this goal was reached based on the participation of approximately 15% of our parish families.

I express my gratitude to all those who have made a generous pledge to the ADA, as well as to the many dedicated parishioners who give in the Sunday collection or in support of tuition assistance at St. Thomas School.

At the same time, there is also a challenge for those who have not taken part. If you haven't made a pledge, I still encourage you to do so. Every dollar over our goal comes back to the parish as a rebate. (Rebates are not counted as income for the purpose of calculating next year's goal for the ADA!) Also, if you haven't given to our Sunday offertory, please consider taking a more active role in support of your parish.

We count on your support to manage our expenses, including the added position of Director of Faith Formation this year, as well as the increased cost of inflation that we all experience.

Thank you for your generous participation and contribution to St. Thomas the Apostle Parish!

# Winter Coat Drive




St. Thomas Parish will once again be participating in a Winter Coat Drive, to benefit the Salvation Army Coats for Kids program, serving those less fortunate in our community.






