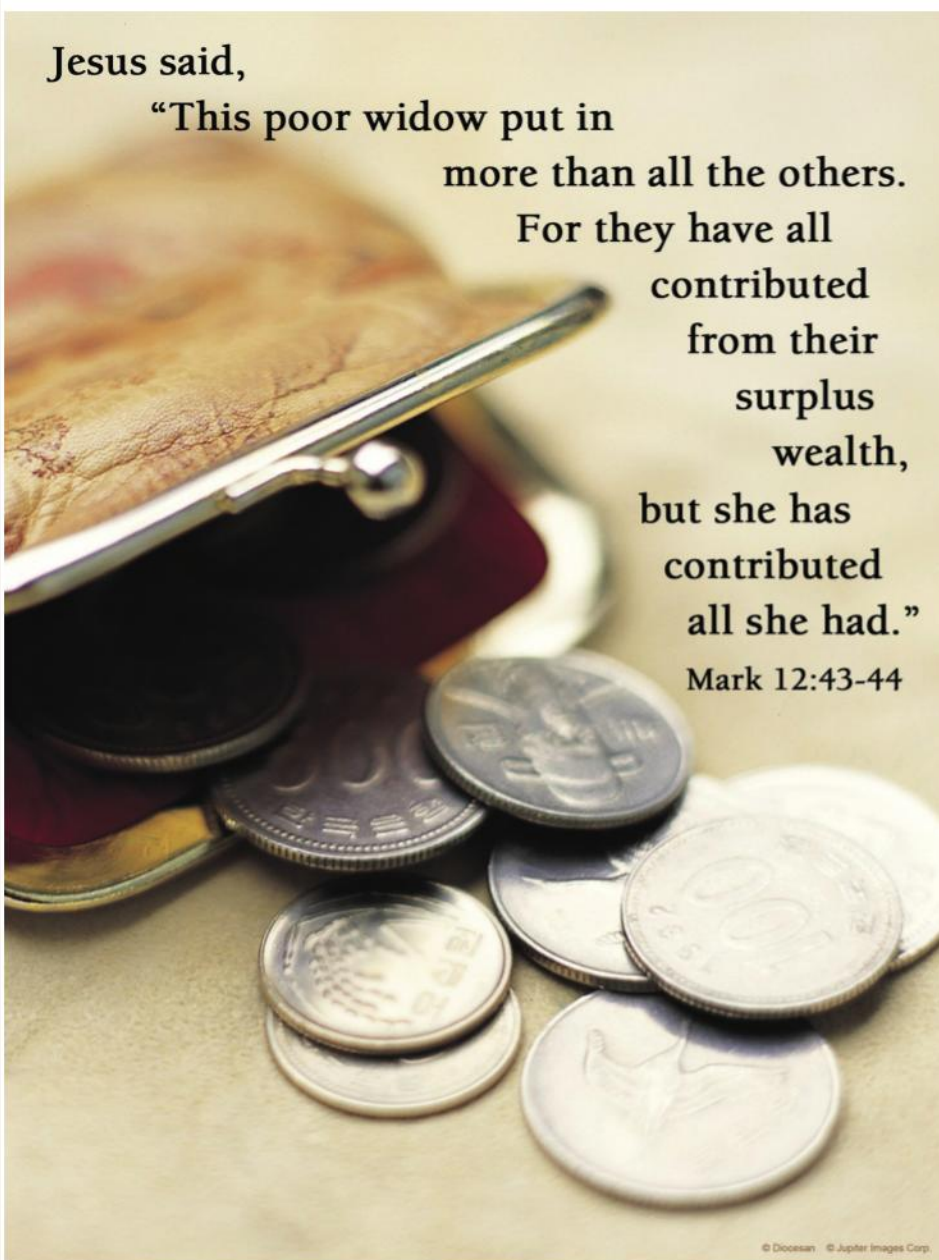

The windows of the south transept of the original church will be reframed and re-leaded. I will mention this in the Annual giving letter that comes out shortly. These windows are an irreplaceable treasure and I want to make sure we care for them so they will augment the beauty of our original church and narthex for years to come.
