### From Our Pastor

Toward the end of each year we invite parishioners to contribute to our end-of-year fund that Msgr. Watson established many years ago. This appeal is usually focused on a particular need for the benefit of the parish or school. This year, I draw your attention to two items: one repair we made earlier and one we will make soon. Earlier in 2024, we repaired the roof above the main entrance on Lake Avenue. This repair solved a persistent water leak that we had in the narthex area. Recently, we identified the need to repair the wood frames and the seals around two stained glass windows on the south side of the narthex area. Thank you for your response to our traditional end-of-year appeal.

We have also been able to make additional repairs to our parking lot thanks to generous donations. This work will fix some potholes that have been developing in the areas where students are traditionally dropped off and picked up. I am thankful for the generosity of our parishioners.

With the help of our Director of Faith Formation, we have helped 28 students who are in the process of becoming Catholic or catching up on their sacraments. This is in addition to the 16 candidates in our OCIA program this year. I mention this because you may not be aware of the number of people who are seeking to come to the Catholic Faith or grow in their Catholic Faith. Please pray for them as they continue on their journey.



### From your Parish Nurse

### **November is National Diabetes Month**

Diabetes is a disease that occurs when your blood glucose, also called blood sugar, is too high. It affects about 38 million Americans, including adults and youth. Diabetes can damage the eyes, kidneys, nerves, and heart, and it is linked to some types of cancer.

But there's also good news: Taking charge of your health may help you prevent diabetes health problems.

### Know your risk for developing diabetes

You are <u>more likely to develop type 2 diabetes</u> if you are overweight or obese; are age 35 or older; have a family history of diabetes; are African American, American Indian, Asian American, Hispanic or Latino, or Pacific Islander; are not physically active; or have prediabetes.

# Manage your blood glucose, blood pressure, and cholesterol levels

Preventing diabetes or managing diabetes as soon as possible after diagnosis may help prevent diabetes health

problems. You can start by managing your diabetes ABCs.

- A is for the A1C test that healthcare professionals use to measure your average blood glucose levels. Some people with diabetes also use devices to track their blood glucose throughout the day and night.
- B is for blood pressure.
- C is for cholesterol.

Ask your health care team what your ABCs goals should be.

### Take small steps toward healthy habits

Lifestyle habits such as planning healthy meals, being physically active, getting enough sleep, and not smoking may help you prevent diabetes or manage your diabetes ABCs. You don't have to do it all at once. Start slow and build healthier habits from there.

#### Take your medicines on time

Remember to take your medicines even if you feel healthy. Talk with your doctor or pharmacist if you have trouble taking your medicines on time or at the correct dose.




