

Simbang Gabi

This Novena of Masses before Christmas is one of the oldest Christmas traditions in the Philippines, and has been practiced by Filipino Communities here in the U.S.

This year, 2024, is the third year of Simbang Gabi in Peoria, thanks in large part to Peoria's Bishop Louis Tylka (who participated in this religious custom at his former parish in Chicago) and the Franciscan Apostolic Sisters (reviving a tradition which was last observed in Peoria in 2007).

Since there are Filipinos who belong to the different parishes in the Peoria area, Bishop Lou wanted the Masses to be celebrated in different churches to mobilize the community and invite other parishioners.

The Simbang Gabi Novena will begin at the Cathedral of St. Mary with the first Mass (Saturday, December 14) celebrated by Bishop Lou.


