Sunday, February 2 – Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord



The Feast of the Presentation is the 40th day after Christmas when Jesus was presented in the Temple by Joseph and Mary according to the Law of Moses. In the Presentation, Jesus was

recognized by Simeon and the Prophetess, Anna, as the Christ-Messiah, as a Priest, and as the Lord and Savior. He is the light who came into the world to dispel sin and darkness. As the light of the world, it has become tradition to bless candles on this day. Hence the alternative title of this day: Candlemas day.

Our principal 10:00 a.m. Mass will begin in the narthex with the blessing of candles. We will bless candles that will be used throughout the liturgical year at St. Thomas. We will also bless candles for parishioners. St. Thomas will provide one candle for each family to be carried in procession. Furthermore, every parishioner is invited to bring in their own candles to be blessed at this Mass. Blessed candles are traditionally lit during storms or in the rooms of the sick. They can also be used during prayer at other family celebrations.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



Doing God's Will

Jesus said to pick up your cross and follow me. Your cross, meaning all your problems and life's challenges and still do His will no matter what.

What is His will?

Jesus said the *poor you will always have with you*. Jesus called on the church to seek out the poor and care for them.

Mother Teresa said *One thing that I ask of you: Never be afraid of giving. There is a deep joy in giving since what we receive is much more than we give*. After witnessing a widow donate two small copper coins to the temple treasury Jesus said *Amen I say to you. This poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury*. It's not about the amount of money as much as the amount of sacrifice you put into the offering.

I joined the St. Vincent de Paul Society 3 years ago because I felt a calling to help the poor. I also knew that I knew nothing about the poor, and I also knew I had misconceptions about the poor. St. Vincent de Paul Society changed that.

One neighbor my partner and I visited was a young single mother with 2 kids and had just gotten a better job. She was finally able to rent an apartment. She had no electricity because there was an old bill that needed to be paid before the power could be turned on. We determined that she made enough money at this new job to get by, but she just needed a little help getting started. We were able to get her old bill paid to get the power turned on, and we also helped her out with some furniture and we signed her up for the Giving Tree at St. Thomas. Because of all your generosity she and the kids had a gift filled Christmas. Not everyone can actively seek the poor. But a good way to do God's will is to actively support St. Vincent de Paul Society. We can do the leg work for you. Like the widow - please give until it hurts a little.

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2025-2026 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under **Catholic Schools** and then under **John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship**. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist at the bottom of the webpage for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: online.factsmgmt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2025-2026 school year must reapply. Deadline date for the completed application is **April 25, 2025**. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2025.
