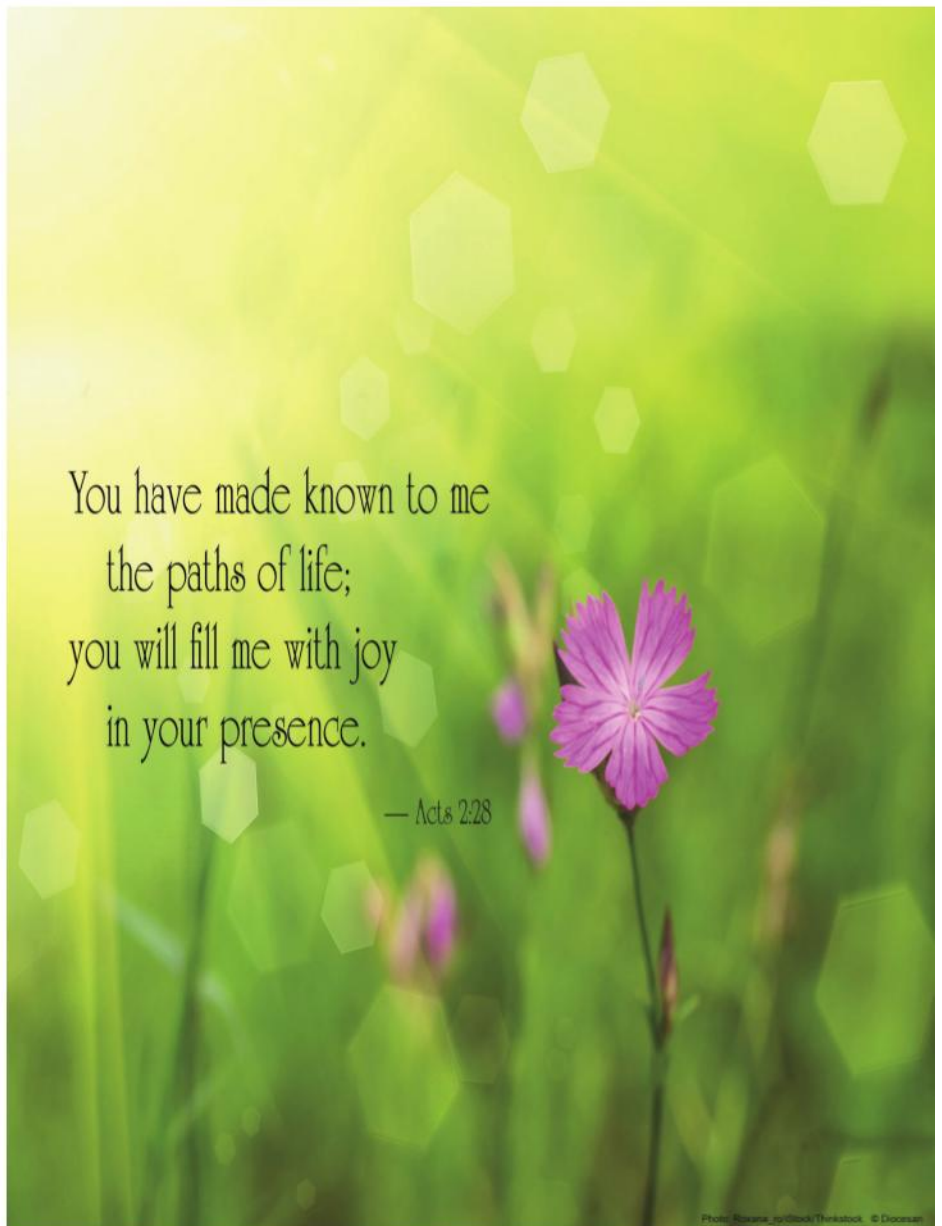

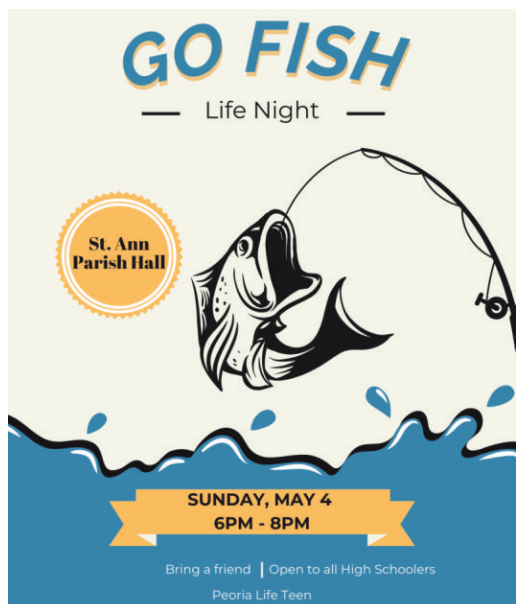

FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

SHALL WE NOT HEED THE REQUEST OF THE WOUNDED HEART OF OUR MOTHER?

On December 10, 1925, our Loving Mother Mary, appearing to Lucy, the only survivor of those who saw our Lady at Fatima, spoke these heart-rending words: "My child, behold My Heart surrounded with the thorns which ungrateful men place therein at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. You, at least, try to console Me. Announce in My name that I promise to assist at the hour of death, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, shall: 1. Go to confession* and receive Holy Communion, 2. Recite the Rosary, 3. And keep Me company for a quarter of an hour while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, 4. With the intention of making reparation to Me. I promise to assist them at the hour of their death with all the graces necessary to save their souls." *The Confession may be made during the eight days before or after the Communion.

Beginning May 3, please join us once a month in prayer to honor our Blessed Mother and to make reparation for the sins against her Immaculate Heart. Rosary begins at 7:35 am. Mass at 8:00 am. Confession schedule as posted in the bulletin.
