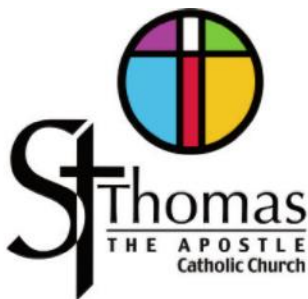

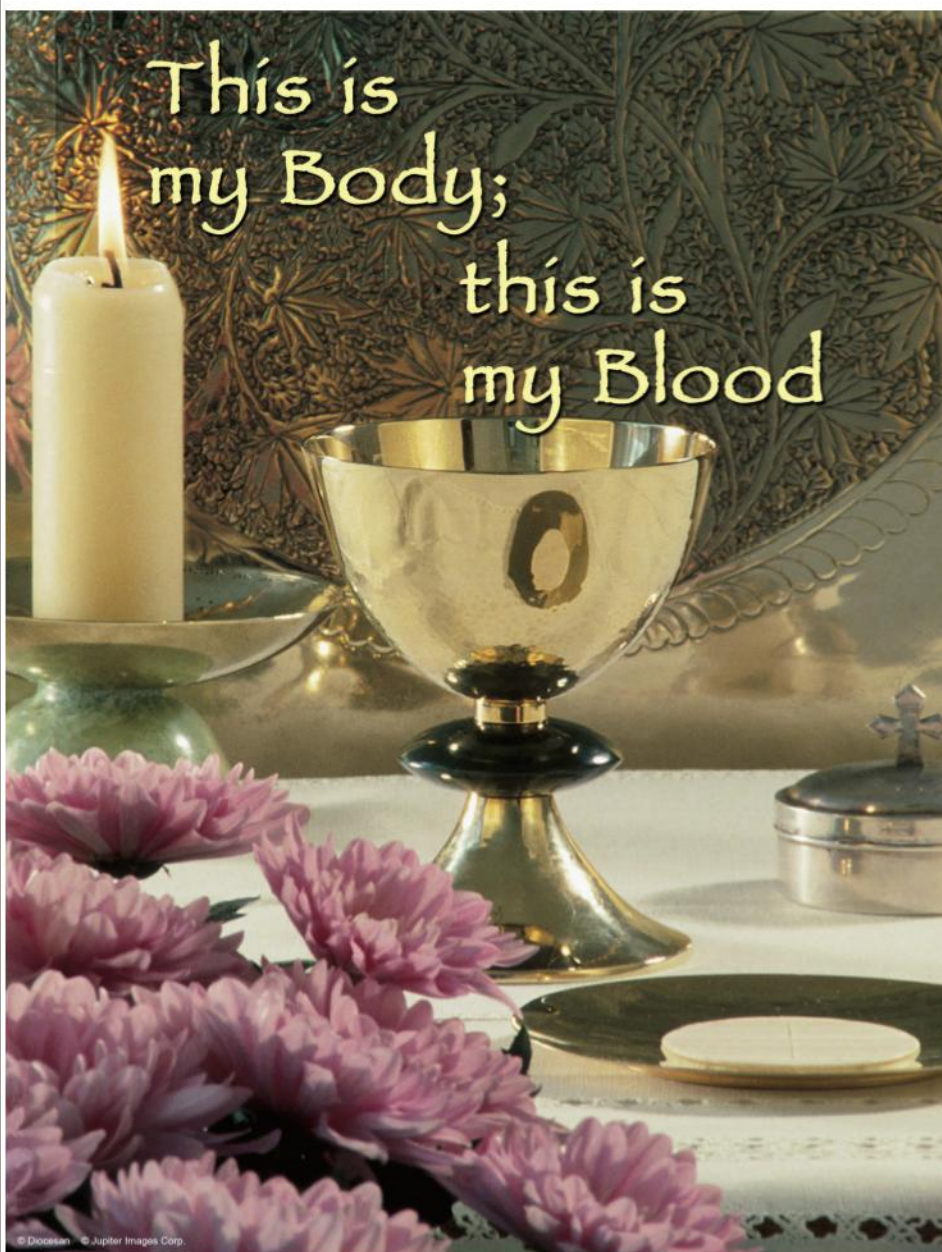

From Our Pastor

Happy feast of Corpus Christi! This weekend we will have a Eucharistic procession after the 10 AM Mass. This devotion is a witness to our belief in the real presence of Jesus Christ who comes to us personally in the Eucharist. Thank you to everyone who has supported this effort, including the Knights of Columbus and the city of Peoria Heights. Some parishioners have asked about the availability of more frequent adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. I will evaluate this request after receiving more feedback from those who are interested.

Next weekend we will celebrate Sts. Peter and Paul which falls on Sunday this year. This special solemnity also invites us to remember the successor of St. Peter and the Vicar of Christ, Pope Leo XIV.

We also have the celebration of our patron, St. Thomas, whose feast day is July 3rd. This solemnity is often overshadowed by the public holiday of the Fourth of July. This year, we will try something new. On the vigil of St. Thomas, July 2nd, we will offer an evening Mass to honor St. Thomas followed by a sample of international cuisine from different parishioners of our St. Thomas Parish family. Join us on Wednesday of next week to honor St. Thomas and celebrate the variety of ethnicities in our parish family.

Last weekend, I announced the possibility that our organist, Steve Harms, took a new job that might require him to leave St. Thomas. In the meantime, I was happy to learn that circumstances changed and Steve will stay with us at St. Thomas. I am grateful for his leadership of our music program.

Finally, our finance committee reviewed tuition assistance requests for next year at St. Thomas School. We were able to make many generous grants especially to our most needy families at St. Thomas. This was possible thanks to the generous donations to the *Msgr. Watson Scholarship Fund* and the contributions made to the *Sponsor-a-Student* offering. Although you may not know the specific family you are helping through your contribution, please know that many of our families count on generous donors to be able to afford a Catholic education.

In addition to the generous support of our school, I also thank you for remembering your support of our regular parish offertory. I count on your regular contributions to meet our parish budget and the activities of our parish. Please remember to give your support generously and regularly to keep our parish strong.

10 Early Signs and Symptoms of Alzheimer's and Dementia

Memory loss that disrupts daily life may be a symptom of Alzheimer's or other dementia. Alzheimer's is a brain disease that causes a slow decline in memory, thinking and reasoning skills. There are 10 warning signs and symptoms. If you notice any of them, don't ignore them. Schedule an appointment with your doctor.

1 Memory loss that disrupts daily life

One of the most common signs of Alzheimer's disease, especially in the early stage, is forgetting recently learned information. Others include forgetting important dates or events, asking the same questions over and over, and increasingly needing to rely on memory aids (e.g., reminder notes or electronic devices) or family members for things they used to handle on their own.

What's a typical age-related change?

Sometimes forgetting names or appointments, but remembering them later.

2 Challenges in planning or solving problems

Some people living with changes in their memory due to Alzheimer's or other dementia may experience changes in their ability to develop and follow a plan or work with numbers. They may have trouble following a familiar recipe or keeping track of monthly bills. They may have difficulty concentrating and take much longer to do things than they did before.

What's a typical age-related change?

Making occasional errors when managing finances or household bills.

3 Difficulty completing familiar tasks

People living with memory changes from Alzheimer's or other dementia often find it hard to complete daily tasks. Sometimes they may have trouble driving to a familiar location, organizing a grocery list or remembering the rules of a favorite game.

What's a typical age-related change?

Occasionally needing help to use microwave settings or to record a TV show.

4 Confusion with time or place

People living with Alzheimer's or other dementia can lose track of dates, seasons and the passage of time. They may have trouble understanding something if it is not happening immediately. Sometimes they may forget where they are or how they got there.

What's a typical age-related change?

Getting confused about the day of the week but figuring it out later.

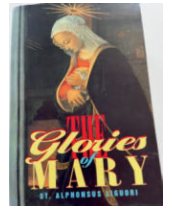
