

From Our Pastor

We began a new school year this week at St. Thomas. However, for the adults, it is also a time to learn more about our Catholic Faith. After Mass this weekend, you are welcome to sign up for a number of programs for adult education.

That Man is You is available for the men of the parish, including our school dads. This is the 10th year for TMIY and will focus on a theme of Apostleship for a new year. The men meet each Friday morning for breakfast refreshments, a video, and group discussion.

Women of the Word is available for the women of the parish, including school moms. This program follows the Paradisus Dei program She Shall Be Called Woman, and will focus on the theme of Love Unveiled. The women meet twice a month on Thursday evenings for evening refreshments, a video, and group discussion. Both programs have been well received by the participants.

A new program will be introduced this year called *Inclusion*, hosted by Michael Gormley. Michael Gormley presented a parish mission here over a year ago. *Inclusion* will help you better understand the biblical foundations of the Catholic Church. It is good to be able to explain what we believe as Catholics and why the Church teaches what it does, using both the Bible and history. This program will take place on Monday evenings beginning *September 8* and is open to all adults.

Finally, those who are interested in exploring the Catechism of the Catholic Church, or learning about the Faith in order to become Catholic are encouraged to participate in OCIA (the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults). These classes will take place on Wednesday evenings at 7 pm beginning September 3rd. The schedule of classes is posted on the parish website.

Please take some time to consider these programs and what might be beneficial for your spiritual growth and enrichment this year.


