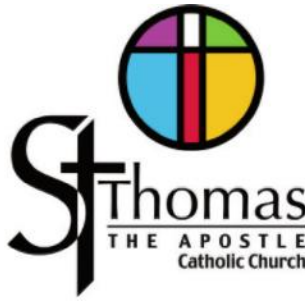

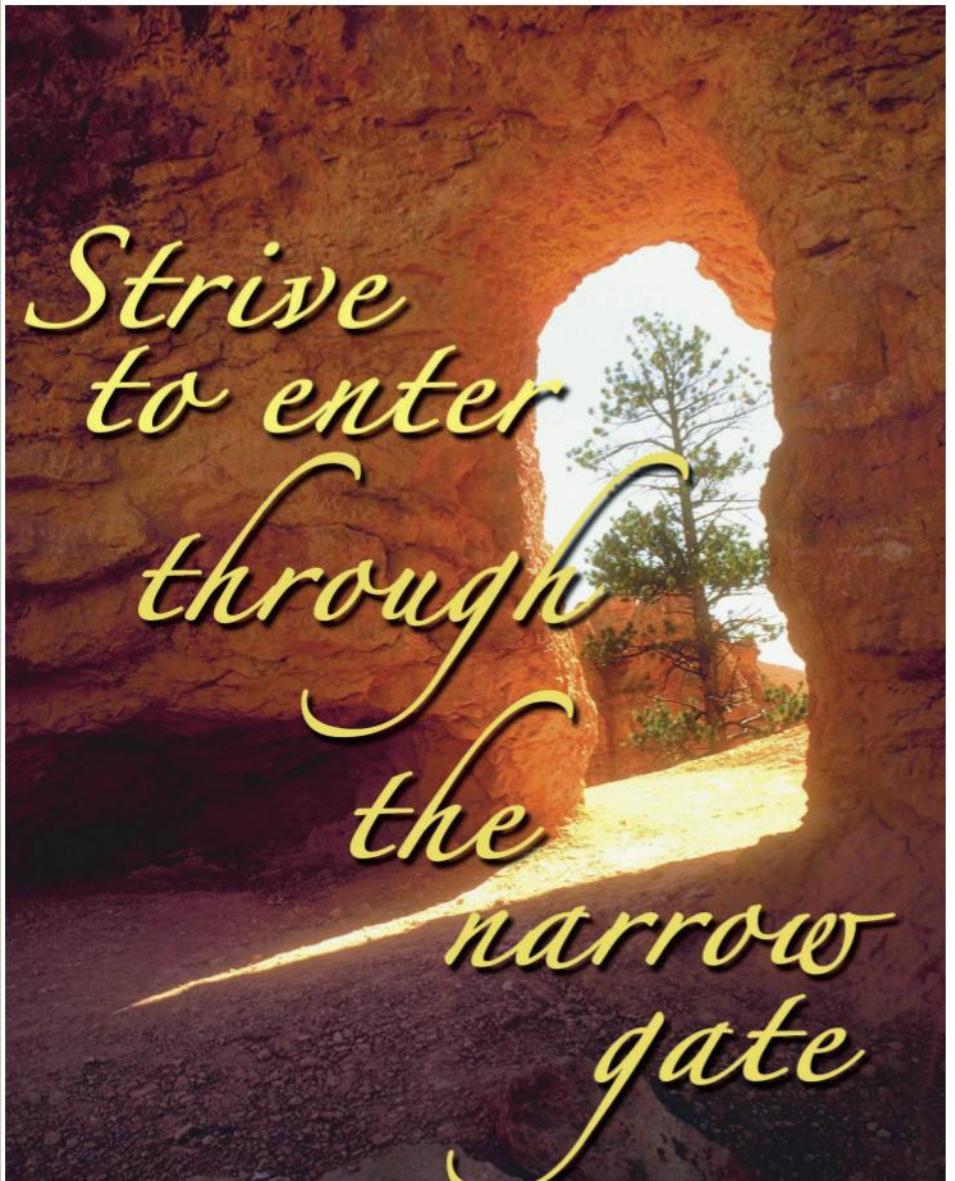

Your donations to St. Thomas can be safely made by check or cash through the Sunday collection, or online through our parish website. QR Codes are available in the Narthex to help you. Some parishioners use their own bill pay services. Our parish office can also help you set up a monthly electronic donation if you prefer.

Unless you prefer to give electronically, the parish office sends envelopes to parishioners in the mail. Contribution envelopes can be sent for those who want to contribute monthly or weekly according to your preference. If you don't receive envelopes or want to adjust your envelopes, please contact the parish office.

As we begin a new school year and a new fiscal year, if you haven't reviewed your regular parish contributions, please do so. If you haven't increased your donation in a while, please consider doing so to help us meet our expenses. Thank you for your support and your generosity.
