

From Our Pastor

Last weekend, we introduced this year's Annual Diocesan Appeal collection. Our goal is \$110,554. I encourage you to watch the video for the ADA which describes the programs that are supported by the Diocese of Peoria. Visit www.cdop.org/ada.

This year, the ADA highlights the training of seminarians and new priests to replace our retired priests, our family life programs such as the Genesis Retreat for engaged couples preparing for marriage, and our Catholic Schools. I encourage you to return the pledge card you picked up at Church or that you received in the mail. You can also contribute online at the same website as above.

Our Progressive Dinner this year will take place on November 8th, with a theme of *Thanksgiving* for our past. As the Diocese celebrates 150 years since its foundation, we remember our founding pastor, who was born 120 years ago and the legacy which he left us at St. Thomas. Our Progressive Dinner will raise money to add additional security items to our school and to replace the chairs in the Parish Hall.

Regarding school security, we will add restrictions for safety to our school Masses. The church doors will be locked during school Mass, and we will generally limit those who can attend to our school families and relatives. The men of the parish are encouraged to join the Knights and we are grateful for their service to the Church and their volunteerism in our own parish.

Donations in these envelopes serve the needs of the poor in our community, just as the donations placed in the wood boxes at the beginning of each month. As the Society is separately incorporated, please make checks for the poor out to St. Vincent de Paul Society and not St. Thomas Parish.
