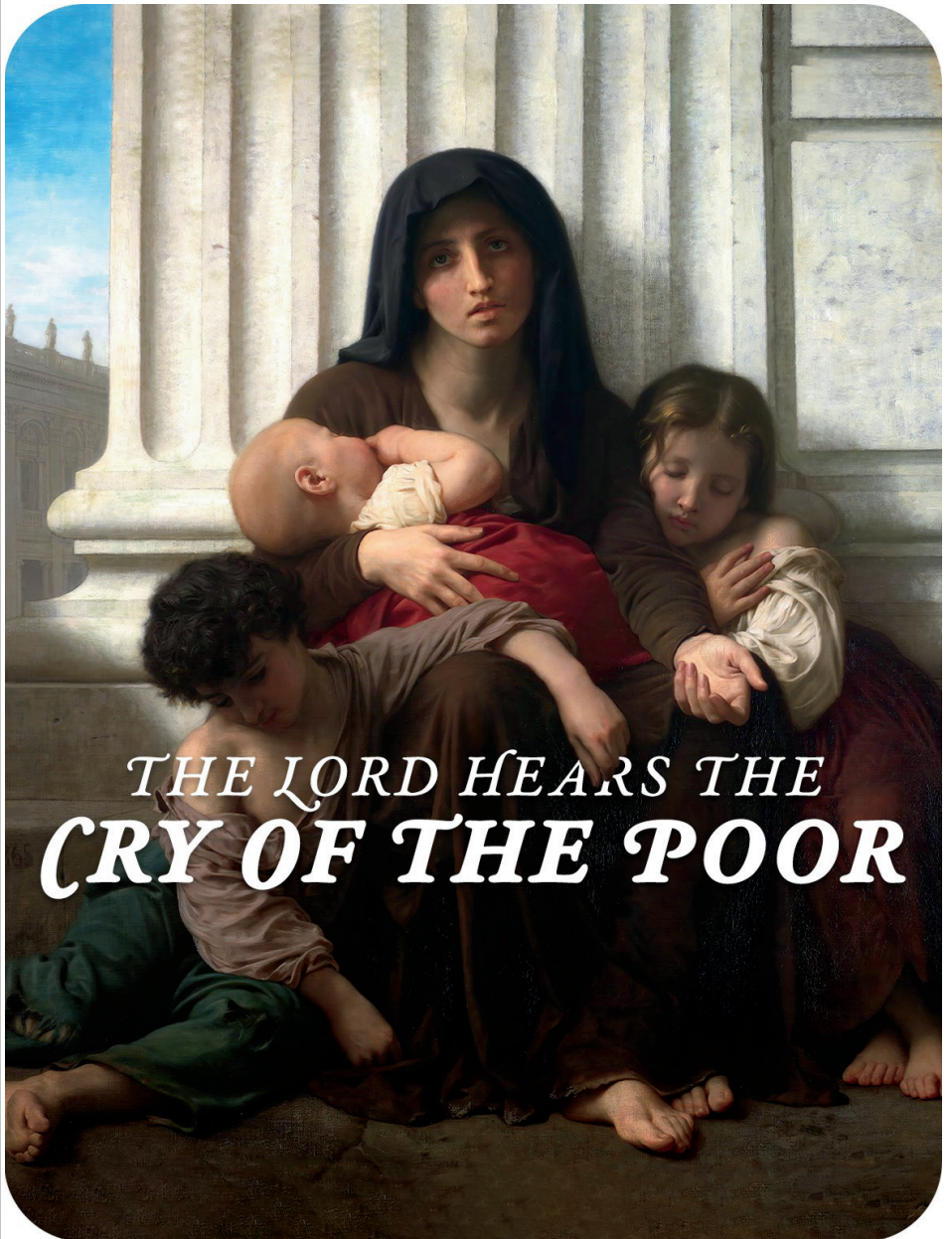

Last week, I attended the Canon Law Society of America convention. During the convention, I was elected to the Board of Governors of the CLSA. This position adds some responsibilities, but fortunately, most of the work done by the Board is done online and meetings are virtual.

Last Sunday, Bishop Tylka announced the renovation of the Spalding Institute building to feature Fulton Sheen. The Spalding building will be lovingly preserved and given new life as a means of honoring her most famous valedictorian. The Sheen Experience will be more than a museum and will engage the increasing number of visitors who come to Peoria to venerate Archbishop Sheen.

This weekend, Father Leo will make his mission appeal on behalf of his Diocese in Tanzania. This parish has generously supported the various missions in Africa in previous years and we look forward to this opportunity to help those who are in need. The Church in Africa is growing and is in need our help.

This Thursday we will have an extra holy hour at 7:00 p.m. The Diocese of Peoria is honoring her 150th anniversary by sending a monstrance around to each of the schools during this celebration. We will take advantage by using the same monstrance for a parish holy hour.

Finally, All Saints Day falls on Saturday, November 1st, and is not obligatory this year. You are welcome to attend Mass at 8:00 a.m. Next Sunday will be All Souls' Day and will be marked by our prayers for the poor souls in Purgatory.

How does the St. Vincent de Paul Society differ from a social service agency?

Client Visit from Agency:

Meet, assess need, dispense financial assistance if eligible according to stated rules.

Neighbor Visit from Vincentian:

Meet, listen, "accompany" neighbor with compassion, encouragement, prayer, in kind assistance (such as food, household items, clothing), follow up later if needed.

When you support SVdP, you are not just offering immediate, concrete assistance to others, though that alone is a wonderful gift. You are allowing us privileged Vincentians the opportunity to walk with the poor – even if briefly – and to ease their burden, person to person.

As Pope Leo stated in his Exhortation '**Dilexi Te**' (I Have Loved You), issued last week:

No Christian can regard the poor simply as a societal problem...we are asked to devote time to the poor, to give them loving attention, to listen to them with interest, to stand by them in difficult moments...

Next month we will offer you our year end report. Please know that those numbers will reflect quantity, but we strive to make our home visits so much more. In so doing, we continue to be transformed.

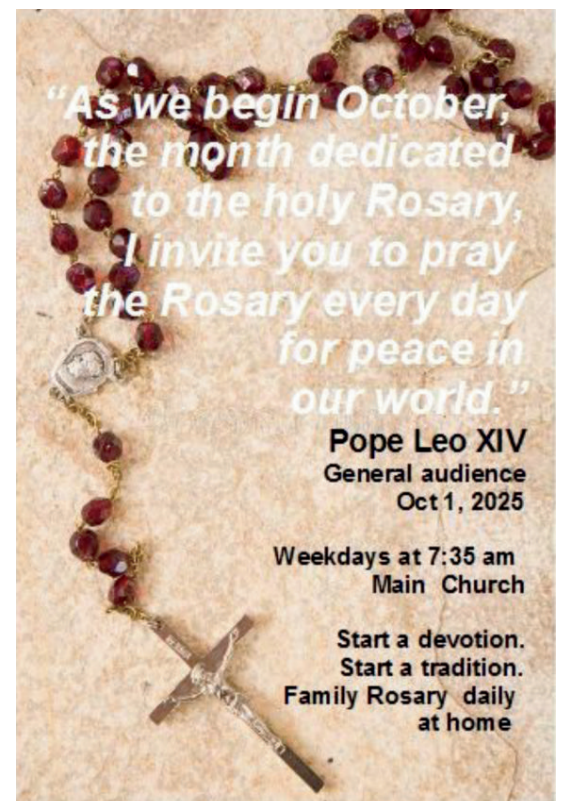

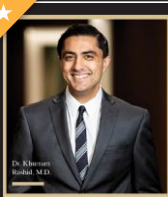
