From Our Pastor

We began the month of November with All Saints Day on Saturday and this weekend is All Souls Day, a time to pray for the poor souls in Purgatory. For those who are destined for Heaven, but who still need to be purified from the stain left by our sins – and that may be most of us! – Purgatory is a gift from God by which we can be purified before passing into the pure light of Heaven. Every soul in Purgatory will go to Heaven.

The good news is that we can help the souls in Purgatory by our prayers. During November, we put out the Book of the Dead in which we record the names of those who have passed. We should all pray for the faithful departed during this month and ask for the repose of their souls. Praying for the dead is a spiritual work of mercy and a great act of charity.

How does the St. Vincent de Paul Society differ from a social service agency?

Client Visit from Agency:

Meet, assess need, dispense financial assistance if eligible according to stated rules.

Neighbor Visit from Vincentian:

Meet, listen, "accompany" neighbor with compassion, encouragement, prayer, in kind assistance (such as food, household items, clothing), follow up later if needed.

When you support SVdP, you are not just offering immediate, concrete assistance to others, though that alone is a wonderful gift. You are allowing us privileged Vincentians the opportunity to walk with the poor – even if briefly – and to ease their burden, person to person.

As Pope Leo stated in his Exhortation 'Dilexi Te' (I Have Loved You), issued last week:

No Christian can regard the poor simply as a societal problem...we are asked to devote time to the poor, to give them loving attention, to listen to them with interest, to stand by them in difficult moments...

Next month we will offer you our year end report. Please know that those numbers will reflect quantity, but we strive to make our home visits so much more. In so doing, we continue to be transformed.
