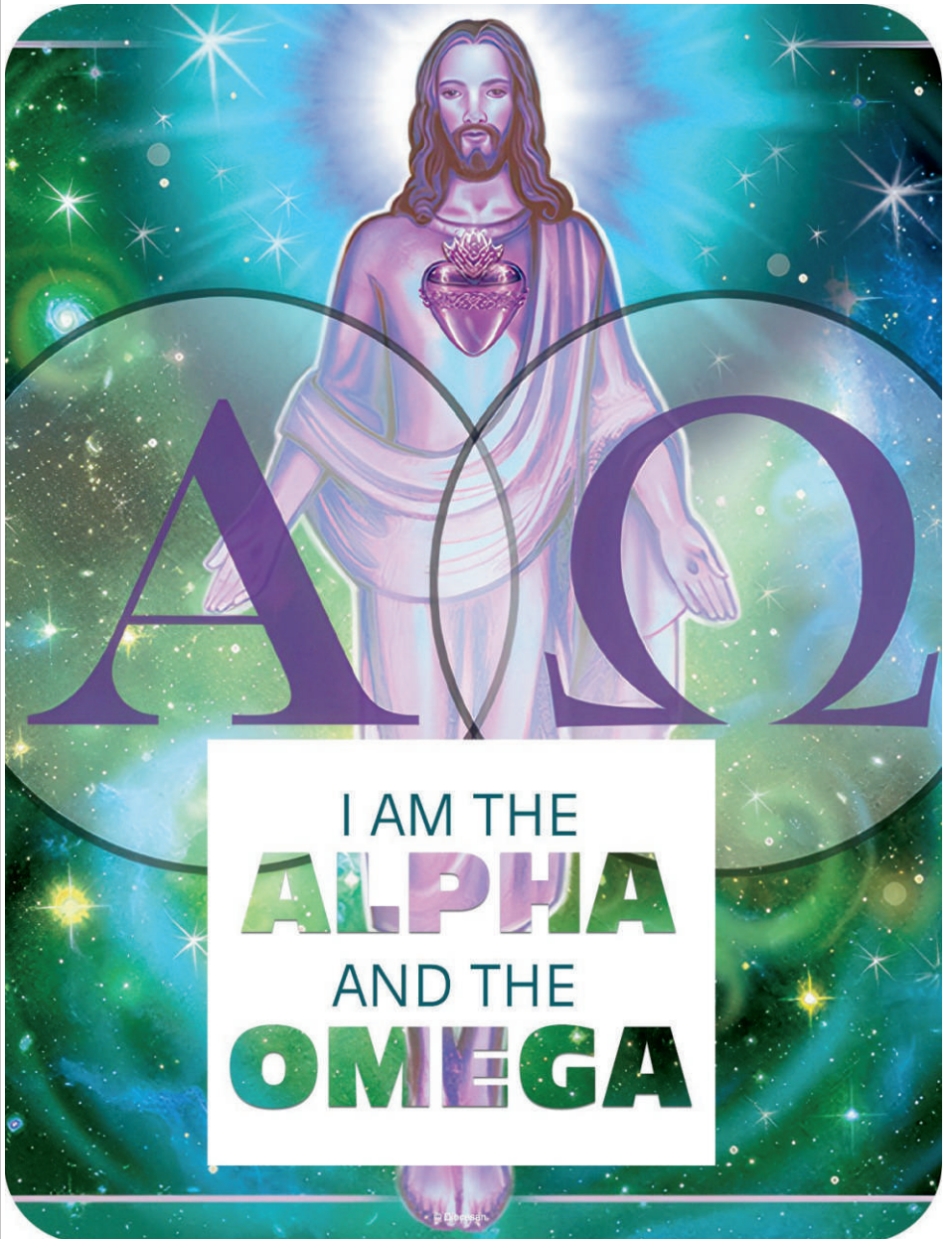

We celebrate the last Sunday of the Church year this weekend with Christ the King. The Kingship of Christ is shown most perfectly in the Gospel reading of Jesus reigning from the cross. This is a good point of meditation for each of us as we consider the crosses and sufferings that we are called to offer up in union with Our Lord.

This weekend, and during the weekends of Advent, we will add additional confession times. Confessions will be heard after all Masses, including on Sundays. Please take advantage of this opportunity for reconciliation as we prepare for Christmas.

During the Thanksgiving break, we will have some parking lot repairs made. This will only affect those who attend daily Mass, but please be aware that some parts of the parking lot will be off limits as this work is done.

Next weekend the Diocese of Peoria asks us to take up a collection for our seminarians by supporting the Msgr. George Carton seminarian endowment.
