

Neither I nor any staff member at St. Thomas will ever email you, text you, or call you to ask for gift cards. The scam works by asking for the gift card numbers, often to help "a sick cancer patient" or for some other fictional need. This is simply an attempt to take advantage of your good will and steal your money. If the crisis is presented as an "emergency" requiring your immediate response, you are being scammed.

This first Sunday of December is a Donut Sunday, and we invite you to come downstairs for coffee and refreshments after the Sunday morning Masses.

Next weekend, we will have our traditional Open House which is a time to thank everyone in the parish for your support and your volunteerism at St. Thomas. More elaborate refreshments will be served after all weekend Masses. We also welcome the Franciscan Sisters of John the Baptist to sell their crafts as they have done in the past. We will set up tables with information for a Ministry Fair. By stopping at the tables, you can learn about activities or groups you can join to support St. Thomas or the other needs in our community. 


