

From Our Pastor

Next Monday there is a special feast day that is connected with Christmas. February 2nd is the traditional day to celebrate the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple, 40 days after Christ's birth. This marks the end of the Christmastide.

On this day, we remember Mary and Joseph taking Jesus into the Temple for his purification. This was done to fulfill the law. At the same time, the Holy Spirit inspired Simeon and the Prophetess Anna to recognize Jesus as the Messiah. This mystery is recalled in the fourth Joyful mystery of the Rosary.

This day, also called Candlemas, is a traditional day to bless candles when the light of Christ came into the temple. At the 7 AM Mass on Monday, February 2nd, we will bless candles for use in the church and will have a procession from the narthex into the church for Mass. Please join us for daily Mass for this special feast day.







Welcome Fr. Pat



My name is Fr. Patrick DeMeulemeester. I realize the name may scare you, but I have good news, you can call me Fr. Pat. Many have asked me the nationality of my name and they pick up a slight accent when I speak. My parents are immigrants to this country from Belgium. The language we spoke at home was Flemish, which is mostly Dutch with a little French.

I grew up in East Moline, the Quad Cities. I attended elementary school at St. Mary's Catholic School and then United Township High School, graduating in 1982. I worked as a janitor for St. Mary's from my sophomore year of high school until 1988 when I entered the seminary.

I attended Holy Apostles College and Seminary in Cromwell Connecticut in 1988 for four years. Then I attended Mt. St. Mary's Seminary for three years and was ordained a priest for Peoria in 1995.

I was a parochial Vicar for two years at Holy Family in Lincoln. Then became a pastor for six years at St. Patrick's Elkhart, St. Thomas Aquinas, Mt. Pulaski. Then I moved to Rock Island where I became Pastor of St. Mary's and St. Joseph's for two years. Then I was assigned for three years to St. Philomena in Monticello. Then for over seventeen years I was Pastor at Sacred Heart in Granville and St. Patrick's in Hennepin. Then as you probably already know, I was assigned to OSF as assistant chaplain on November 1 until January 30.

Now, I am overjoyed at returning to parish life as parochial vicar at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish. I pray that Jesus may bless our time together and lead us ever closer to Himself.
