Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Years of war in Ukraine have profoundly affected both Ukrainian society and the Church in Ukraine. From the beginning, the laity have played a significant role in responding to the needs of displaced families, orphaned children, and other victims of the conflict. In the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church's Exarchate of Lutsk, laypeople such as catechists, parish pastoral and economic council members, and priest's wives have been called upon to provide faith formation, carefully manage parish resources, and provide emotional and spiritual support to members of the local parish communities.

These laypeople have heeded their call to holiness by bringing their talents and abilities to serve God and their neighbors. The exarchate, with crucial funds received through the Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, has answered the call of Pope Leo to empower and form the laity to help bring the Gospel to the world. The exarchate is hosting formation seminars and trainings for priests' wives, parish pastoral and financial advisors, and catechists so that they might foster spiritual healing and economic recovery amid the devastation of war.

By donating to this special collection when it is taken up in our diocese, you help the Church in Ukraine and more than 25 other countries in Central and Eastern Europe to witness to Christ's mercy, even in the midst of terrible hardship.



Illinois Pro-Life Mass and March

MARCH On Thursday, March 19, you are invited to join thousands of pro-life advocates, being a joyful witness to life and raising your voice for the voiceless at the Illinois Pro-Life Mass and March. The day begins with **Mass at 10 a.m. at the Exposition Building on the grounds of the Illinois State Fairgrounds in Springfield**, celebrated by Bishop Thomas John Paprocki of the Diocese of Springfield and concelebrated by bishops and priests from across the state. **Bishop Louis Tylka of the Diocese of Peoria will be the homilist.** You must register for the Mass at dio.org. The building is not temperature-controlled, so dress accordingly.

After the Mass, there is a rally at the Capitol at 1 p.m. with guest speakers and then a march around the Capitol at 2 p.m. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will also be going on at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield from noon to 5 p.m. Confessions at the Cathedral will also be available from noon to 1 p.m. and 3 to 5 p.m.

Last year, about 2,000 people attended the Illinois Pro-Life March. Students from Catholic grade schools, high schools, and Newman Centers; Priests, seminarians, religious, and the lay faithful from every corner of the diocese and the state also showed up in strong numbers.
