

From Our Pastor

Thank you for your patience as we await the replacement of the coil in the heat exchanger for the church. For the time being, we continue to be without air conditioning until this repair is complete.

St. Thomas is also happy to announce that Father Edward Besigye has been assigned to our parish as parochial vicar. Father Edward is a priest of the Mbarara Archdiocese in Uganda and is new to the United States. Father DeMeulemeester and I are happy to welcome him as he begins to acclimate to service in the Catholic Church in this country. The Bishop will make a decision about Father Edward's permanent assignment when changes are announced for the summer.

Please pray for the OCIA candidates who are preparing to enter the Church at the Easter Vigil. They are close to the end and look forward to baptism or being received into the Church.

As we enter Holy Week, we begin with Palm Sunday Mass. The more solemn procession with palms will take place at the 10:00 a.m. Mass. Please be aware of our services for the Triduum. Holy Thursday Mass is offered only in the evening at 7:30 p.m. with adoration continuing in the chapel until 11:00 p.m.

Good Friday Liturgy is only at 3:00 p.m., though Stations will be offered both at 12:00 and 7:00 p.m.. Confessions will be heard Friday evening at 6:00 p.m..

The only Mass on Holy Saturday is the Easter Vigil at 8:00 p.m..

On Easter Sunday, Masses will be offered at 8:00 and 10:00 a.m., but not at 5 PM.



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I write to you with deep gratitude for your support of last year's Pontifical Good Friday Collection for the Church in the Holy Land. Your generosity supported 23 parishes and helped to keep schools open for over 10,000 pre-K through grade 12 students. It helped to provide assistance to over 9,000 families through weekly food baskets, and to employ more than 1,000 workers in a time where job opportunities are scarce. And it helped to preserve 80 shrines promoting the life of Jesus, the Apostles and prophets.

Although often through adversities, a Christian presence has always remained in the Holy Land since the beginning of the Church. It is important that Christians continue to live, work and pray in the Holy Land, where the Church started. Christians are now less than 2% of the population, with many more potentially leaving. In Bethlehem alone, more than 90 Christian families have left since October 7, 2024. The Holy Shrines must not become like museums - with many visitors, but without a local community.

Thank you for your support of the Pontifical Good Friday Collection on April 3rd. Through this collection you will join with Catholics around the world to stand in solidarity with the Church in the Holy Land, making a difference in the lives of those caught up in war, violence and instability. You become an instrument of peace in a troubled land.

A SENSE OF COMMUNITY

We are called to recognize that suffering is a universal experience, drawing us together in our shared vulnerability with humanity. A sense of community reminds us that we are not alone. In our Vincentians tradition, we are called to recognize our shared humanity with our *Friends in Need*.

This is the story of a Friend in Need that my partner, Dave Schlicksup and I visited. Emmanuel is 73 years old and living on a small Social Security check. For many years, Emmanuel lived in a group home. His situation changed due to circumstances beyond his control, and he was no longer able to live in that group's home. His safety net disappeared. He lost not only his home, but his community. In addition, Emmanuel has many missing teeth which limits him to only eating pureed food. His car radiator is on the brink of failure.

Today, Emmanuel's greatest comfort is his modest apartment and his steadfast relationship with God. In a good month, he is able to pay rent, gas, food, and phone service. Yet he lives without a safety net. An unexpected expense - such as a hospital bill - could easily tip him into crisis.

It is with humility and hope that Emmanuel turns to St. Vincent de Paul. His need is simple: a step toward stability, and peace of mind knowing he has a little reserve income.

As Vincentians, we believe that those who are poor are not a problem to be solved, but friends to be helped. We suspend judgment and offer respect as a gift with our eyes. In serving our "Friends in Need," we encounter Christ..

To our parishioners: thank you! Your generosity makes this sacred work possible. Because of your donations, Emmanuel is not met with judgment, but with compassion, not with isolation, but with community. Your gifts are a living expression of the Gospel, furthering St. Vincent de Paul's call to serve the poor.


