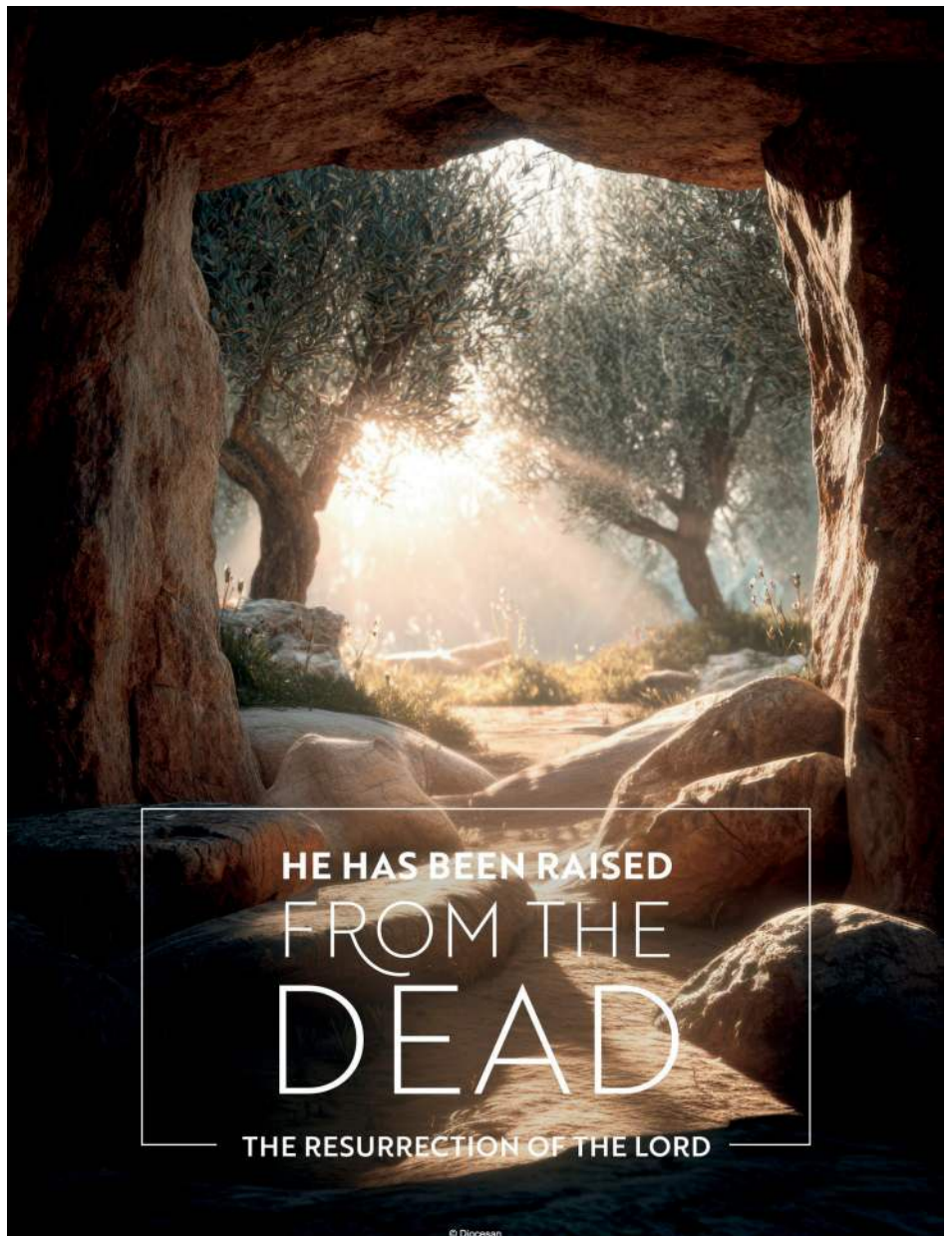

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord





From Our Pastor

Christ is risen, Alleluia! I wish each of you a very happy Easter as we celebrate the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The sacrifices of the Season of Lent now become a cause for joy, as we discipline ourselves to walk with Christ to Calvary so as to follow him also to the resurrection. For those who believe, the empty tomb is not a cause of fear but a reassuring sign of the Lord's power.

Next Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. To honor this special devotion on the octave of Easter, we will have time for adoration at the traditional hour of 3:00 p.m. next Sunday.

Congratulations to all those who entered the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Please continue to pray for them. We now welcome them as full members of St. Thomas Parish and encourage them to take part in our various parish activities.

You are aware that we discovered damage to the coil in our HVAC system and that we have only been able to use outside air to cool the church building. The replacement of the coil has taken both time and money, but it is a necessity in our church building today. In addition to replacing the coil, we will also repair some other parts of the HVAC system that are showing wear since the system was installed 24 years ago. The total cost is \$56,000. We will draw on savings to make this repair, though your financial support of the parish is greatly appreciated to defray this expense.

At the same time, our Diocese looks forward to the Beatification of Archbishop Fulton Sheen on September 24, 2026 in St. Louis. Although the event will be at the large Dome in St. Louis, there will be many events in Peoria throughout *Sheen Week* that will focus on our local area where Sheen grew up. Some parishioners may want to go to St. Louis to attend. It may be possible to rent a bus to take interested parishioners down and back on the day of the Beatification. Please let us know if you are interested.

It may also be possible to add a mosaic of Blessed Fulton to St. Thomas Church, consistent with the other mosaics we have already added. If you're interested in donating to such a mosaic, please let me know.

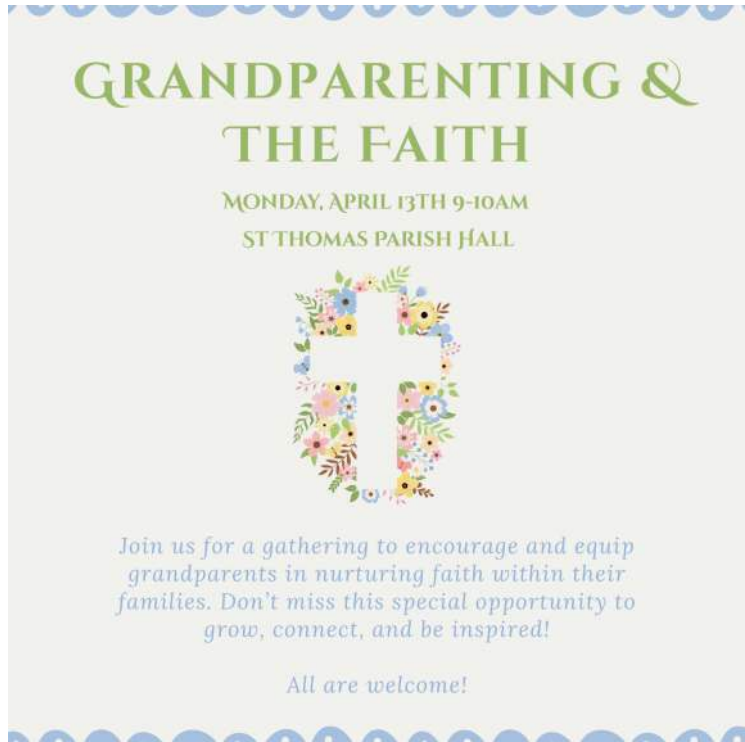

**When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus
A SENSE OF COMMUNITY**

We are called to recognize that suffering is a universal experience, drawing us together in our shared vulnerability with humanity. A sense of community reminds us that we are not alone. In our Vincentians tradition, we are called to recognize our shared humanity with our *Friends in Need*.

This is the story of a Friend in Need that my partner, Dave Schlicksup and I visited. Emmanuel is 73 years old and living on a small Social Security check. For many years, Emmanuel lived in a group home. His situation changed due to circumstances beyond his control, and he was no longer able to live in that group's home. His safety net disappeared. He lost not only his home, but his community. In addition, Emmanuel has many missing teeth which limits him to only eating pureed food. His car radiator is on the brink of failure.






Today, Emmanuel's greatest comfort is his modest apartment and his steadfast relationship with God. In a good month, he is able to pay rent, gas, food, and phone service. Yet he lives without a safety net. An unexpected expense - such as a hospital bill - could easily tip him into crisis. It is with humility and hope that Emmanuel turns to St. Vincent de Paul. His need is simple: a step toward stability, and peace of mind knowing he has a little reserve income.

As Vincentians, we believe that those who are poor are not a problem to be solved, but friends to be helped. We suspend judgment and offer respect as a gift with our eyes. In serving our "Friends in Need," we encounter Christ..

To our parishioners: thank you! Your generosity makes this sacred work possible. Because of your donations, Emmanuel is not met with judgment, but with compassion, not with isolation, but with community. Your gifts are a living expression of the Gospel, furthering St. Vincent de Paul's call to serve the poor.


