Next weekend, we will welcome Fr. Marc Nkulu back to St. Thomas to make a mission appeal on behalf of the Society of African Missionaries. This religious order serves throughout several countries in Africa. Your contributions will help build up the Church in developing areas. Archbishop Sheen considered it a privilege to support the missions, since we are continuing the apostolic mission of preaching Jesus Christ throughout the world.

Four weeks ago we discovered that our air conditioning in the church needed a major repair. Though I hoped it would be repaired last weekend, I am hopeful that it will be completed by this weekend. Thank you for your patience during recent warmer weather.

Bishop Tylka accepted an invitation from our parish for a Q & A with seniors this Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. Seniors are welcome to attend. The session will be an open opportunity to ask the Bishop questions. We look forward to hearing Bishop Tylka speak about his vision, especially as we look forward to the Beatification of Archbishop Fulton Sheen.

As the Cause for Fulton Sheen moves forward, I have reserved a bus for those who would like to travel to the Beatification in St. Louis on Thursday, September 24, and return on the same day.
