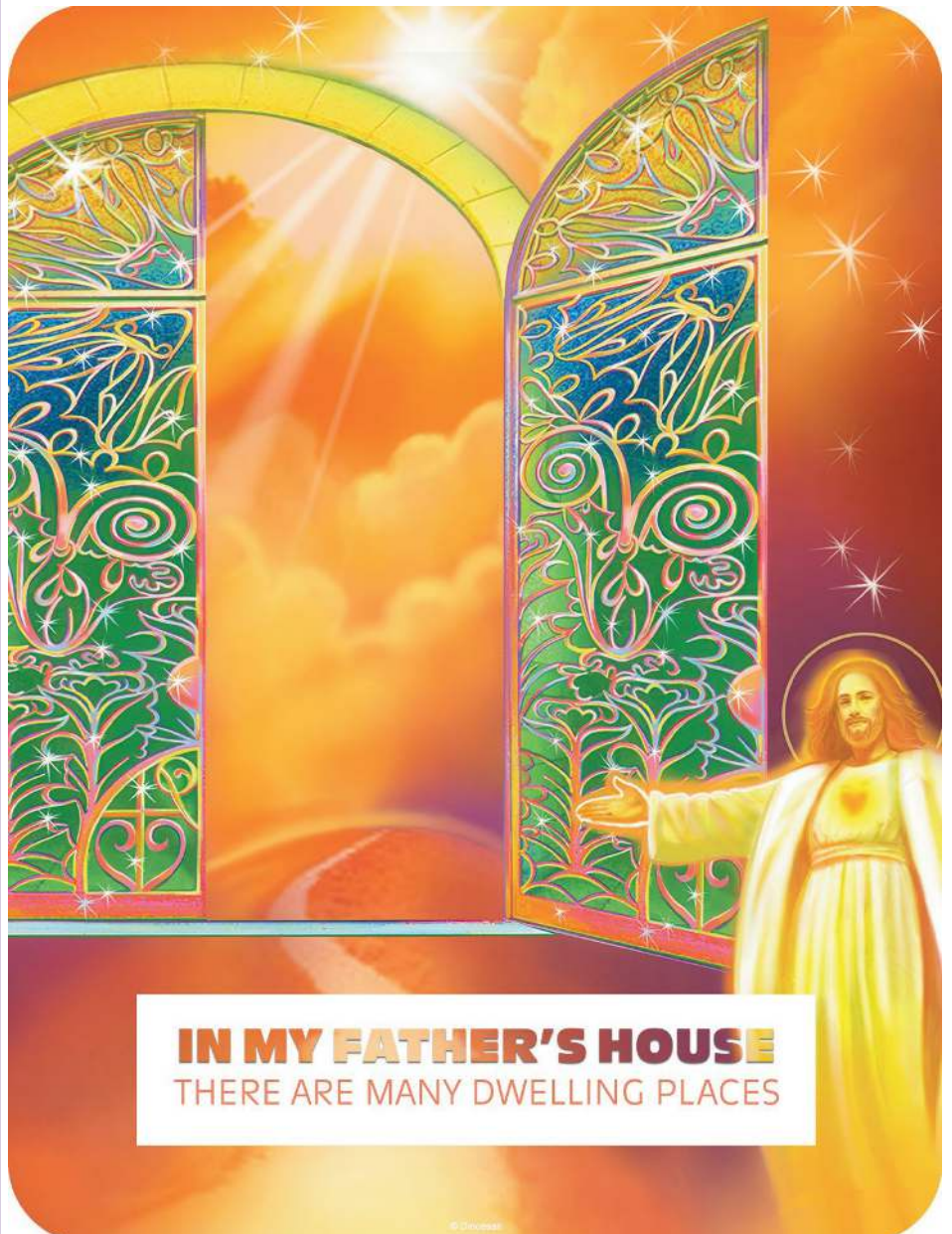

New Tax Deduction for Non-Itemizers

Under current law, taxpayers who take the standard deduction (those who do not itemize) generally cannot deduct charitable contributions. **Beginning in 2026**, the new law restores an above-the-line deduction for cash gifts made to qualified public charities. This means that even if you do not itemize, you can still deduct charitable gifts up to:

- \$1,000 for single taxpayers
- \$2,000 for married couples filing jointly.

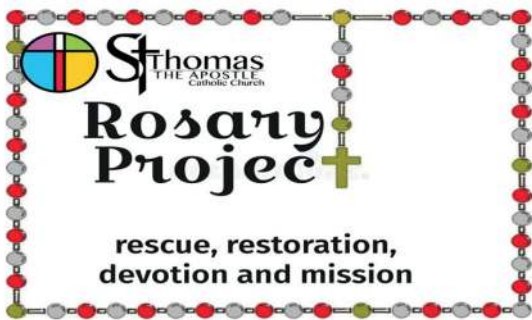


The St. Thomas Food Pantry offers an excellent opportunity for students needing service hours! On Monday and Thursday mornings, federal holidays excepted, the pantry distributes groceries to neighbors in need in the Peoria Heights area. Packing groceries, registering pantry guests, restocking shelves, repackaging food and helping guests to their vehicles are tasks that students will perform while under adult supervision. An additional service opportunity occurs one Thursday afternoon per month when we receive a truckload of food products from Midwest Food Bank. On these days, students help adult volunteers unload the truck, repackage food, rotate stock and stock shelves.
