From Our Pastor

The Easter Season ended last week at Pentecost and we return to Ordinary Time. We also concluded the school year at St. Thomas School, which gives me a moment to look back with gratitude for our faculty and staff for their hard work in serving our parents and students so well. The summer months are important as we clean the school and make necessary repairs. This summer we will finish the security upgrades that were paid for by our Progressive Dinner last year. This will include a protective security film for the school doors and windows and the upgrade of the school office service window.

Following Pentecost, we celebrate special solemnities, including the Trinity this weekend and Corpus Christi next weekend. This weekend, we remember the blessings we receive through the mystery of our one God who is three persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Next weekend, we are privileged to welcome Father Johnpaul Stedwill who will celebrate the Saturday evening Mass on June 6th. Father Stedwill attended St. Thomas School for part of his grade school education and was just ordained as a priest for our diocese last weekend. It is a blessing to welcome a new priest, and this should encourage us also to pray for vocations to the priesthood.

Next weekend, we also look forward to the Corpus Christi procession with the Blessed Sacrament after the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass on June 7th. Join us for the procession as we carry the Eucharist into the public around our parish. At the end of Mass, we place the Eucharist in the monstrance and carry Our Lord to two other devotional altars set up around our campus before we return to the church. The faithful are blessed three times as Benediction takes place at each altar. We join in prayer, proclaiming our faith, and witnessing to our belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

The Diocese of Peoria has produced a pictorial coffee table book on the history of the Diocese and the parishes for our 150th anniversary. This attractive book will be a collector's item and a beautiful commemorative. We have a limited supply of books that can be purchased for \$40 after Mass this weekend or by stopping by the parish office.

When you go to the poor, you encounter Jesus



As a Catholic do you ever feel like the lord is calling you to do more?

You're not sure what he is calling you to do but you're sure he is calling. I felt that same way about 5 years ago. I started looking at the Church website, at all the groups St. Thomas offered. I saw the St. Vincent DePaul Society and how they help the local poor with advice and with the money they get from the monthly collection. Two weeks had gone by, and I was still wondering what God was calling me to do. Then at Saturday evening Mass the St. Vincent DePaul Society gave a short talk after Mass trying to recruit new members. I knew this wasn't a coincidence. I stopped to talk to one of the members and quickly realized this was my calling. Within a few weeks of training, I began to do home visits. Like everyone else, I had my own misconceptions about the poor. I soon realized none of them were true. I also quickly realized I wasn't just helping the poor I was helping myself see the world the way Jesus does. On one visit a lady needed help paying for a car license sticker. She had just been let go from Cat after 14 years. Her husband was still working but their budget was tight. My partner and I talked to her about options and she began to cry. She just couldn't believe she had been fired. Then she told us she had decided to chase a dream of becoming a paid care giver for her Nephew who was mentally disabled. She said she had been praying about a way to help him for a long time. She again started to cry. I asked her do you think God just answered your prayer? She instantly stopped crying and smiled. She said, "I never thought of that. Yes I think he has answered my prayer." We got her a new license sticker and before we left, I asked if she would be alright now? She just smiled and said "yes." Your donations enable the St. Vincent DePaul Society to help our local Friends in need.
